

Stanley Shetler, age 90 of Pigeon, passed away Saturday, April 2, 2016 at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe.

He was born March 30, 1926 to Henry and Emma (Slabaugh) Shetler in Bay Port. After the death of Stanley's mother, Henry was married to Leona Schrock, and they were the parents who raised Stanley and his siblings.

Stanley attended and graduated from Snell Country School, often referred to as "Snell University." On April 23, 1949 he was united in marriage to Elaine M. McMullen at the Bad Axe Methodist Church. She preceded him in death on July 24, 1989.
