Why this is a great opportunity: There is ample opportunity and freedom to spread one's wings because a great foundation has been established by the previous Associate Pastor that will empower the incoming Associate Pastor to come in and flourish. A strong, healthy community congregation with many proven and emerging leaders and our Awana program are both embraced and celebrated by the church as a whole. Our Assistant/Associate Pastor position is for anyone who wants to work with a vibrant church staff that is fully supported by an elder board.

Weekly opportunities to impact the lives of both unbelievers and church family may include:

- Sharing the Gospel and praying with some who avail themselves of our outreach and aid ministries.
- Offering spiritual support to church family and others who are going through various trials.
- Encouraging those gathered on Sunday mornings by assisting in the leading of our weekly worship services.
- Leading/teaching/facilitating some regularly recurring ministries (Bible studies, social ministries, special events, etc.).
- Building relationships with the children and families who are a part of our Preschool (PCCP), Academy (CCA) and Awana ministries by assisting in weekly our Awana ministry, CCA Chapel services and additional opportunities as they arise.

Primary qualifications of the Assistant/Associate Pastor include:

- A clear and concise testimony of personal faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.
- A confident sense of God's calling to full-time pastoral ministry.
- A ministry-related degree from a conservative Bible college (or the equivalent experience).
- A personal life consistent with the Biblical expectations of church leadership.
- A full agreement with the Biblical tenets of faith as expressed in the PCC Constitution's doctrinal statement.
- A willingness to fully support rural ministry as exemplified in the ministry of *Village Missions*.

Secondary, but equally important would be:

- A passion to fulfill the great commission of Jesus Christ
(the spiritual gift of evangelism would be a plus).
- The willingness and ability to lead and/or significantly contribute to a vibrant music ministry.

Although a PCC Assistant/Associate Pastor will not be expected to preach weekly from the pulpit, times will be provided throughout the year to assist in more fully developing that type of ministry as needed.

A goal of our leadership is to more fully integrate those impacted by our outreach ministries (PCCP, CCA, Awana, etc.) into our church family. We are praying for some whom God might use to help facilitate this integration.

The PCC family is supportive of and generous to our leadership. As our pastor(s) minister sacrificially to the flock, our goal is to fully meet the needs of each pastor (& family) enabling them to fulfill their calling.

The Community:

Pahrump is a town of almost 50,000 with a rural flavor but benefits from being approximately an hour from Las Vegas Airport and amenities. While Pahrump has retained some of its agricultural roots it provides access to high-speed internet, box stores, full service medical, hiking trails, public & private education, rodeos, hot air balloons, and exceptional sunsets!

Pahrump Community Church (PCC) was established in 1968 when the town was very small with less than 1,000 residents. Affiliated with *Village Missions** throughout its history, PCC is now one of several dozen churches in the valley and the population of our town has grown to almost 50,000. In many ways, however, we have maintained that small-town rural church feel.

We are an autonomous, independent, non-denominational church with a mutually-beneficial affiliation with *Village Missions*, and every senior pastor of PCC since 1968 has been a Village Missionary. Because of this distinctive relationship, our staff members are familiar with *Village Missions* and support of the vision and philosophy that drives this mission organization.

We are also supportive of missions work at home and abroad. Ten percent of our budget is in direct support of *Village Missions*, and another almost ten percent is in support of other mission ministries and missionaries.

Our worship services are centered around the expositional teaching and preaching of God's Word. Our music ministry features a blend of traditional hymns and more contemporary worship songs carefully vetted for doctrinal integrity. Prayer is prominent both on Sunday mornings and throughout all the ministries of this church.

PCC also serves our unincorporated town by offering a certified *Pahrump Community Church Preschool* (PCCP) program (current enrollment: +/- 70) during the week, and *Abeka*-curriculum K through 9 classes in our *Community Christian Academy* (CCA), (current enrollment: +/- 130).
