

# JOHN G. RADTKE

## 1920 - 1996

John G. Radtke, 75 of Caseville, formerly of Centerline, died of cancer on Saturday, Feb. 10 at his home.

He was born Sept. 28, 1920 in Detroit, son of the late John and Florence (Szczepanski) Radtke. He was united in marriage to Marie Hiller on May 30, 1942 at St. Clement Catholic Church, Centerline.

Mr. Radtke worked as a finish carpenter all his life. He retired from Chrysler Corp. on Oct. 31, 1980 after 30 years of service, building and remodeling offices. He retired in Lake Township in 1982 to the cottage they had purchased in 1967.

He was a member of St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville, Caseville F.O.E., VFW and was a World War II Army veteran, having served in Europe.

Mass of the Resurrection will be celebrated on Tuesday, Feb. 13 at 11 a.m. at St. Roch Catholic Church, Caseville. His close friend, Fr.
