*NO horses are allowed inside concessions area, restrooms, or gazebo *NO whips or crops in any pleasure class

*SCRHA strongly recommends and encourages ALL riders to wear an ASTM/SEI certified helmet

*Shoes will be checked prior to horses entering the ring in all classes with specific shoe restrictions. (No Tungsten shoes allowed in any classes)

*Horse and Rider must be compatible and may be excused from the ring by judge and/or horse show management if perceived to be a danger to themselves/others *SCRHA and show volunteers will NOT be liable for any injury, damage, loss or theft
