Is Our Faith Useless?

This year, Easter Sunday falls on April Fool's Day. What if the resurrection of Jesus was just an elaborate April Fool's joke? Then, we would be the fools. The Apostle Paul says that our faith

would be useless.

(1 Corinthians 15:13-14) If there is no resurrection of the dead, then not even Christ has been raised. And if Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith.

This Easter Sunday, we will examine the evidence of the resurrection. Did Jesus really die, or was he just unconscious? Did he really rise from the dead, or did the apostles hide the body? These are questions many people have who are not yet followers of Jesus. Can you help them to discover the answers?

I encourage you to think of someone who might be wrestling with these questions. Invite them to Easter Sunday to examine the evidence of the resurrection. For two Sundays after Easter, we will continue to explore other questions. Is the Bible reliable? Is the Bible relevant today?

Who can you invite to hear the good news of Jesus? Don't miss the opportunity that God places before you. Begin today by praying and identifying someone to invite. Ask God to move in their hearts to accept the invitation. And invite them to come with you. Trust that God wants to work through YOU!









During springtime, the beauty of God's creation emerges in many ways. Directions: Use the vowel code below to complete Psalm 8:1, NIV.

As you can see from the pictures (taken by our pastor) the event was a hit!






Valentines Dinner Wrap-Up


A new *Standards of Excellence* was introduced. Each team member was challenged to continue their faith journey working towards these standards.
