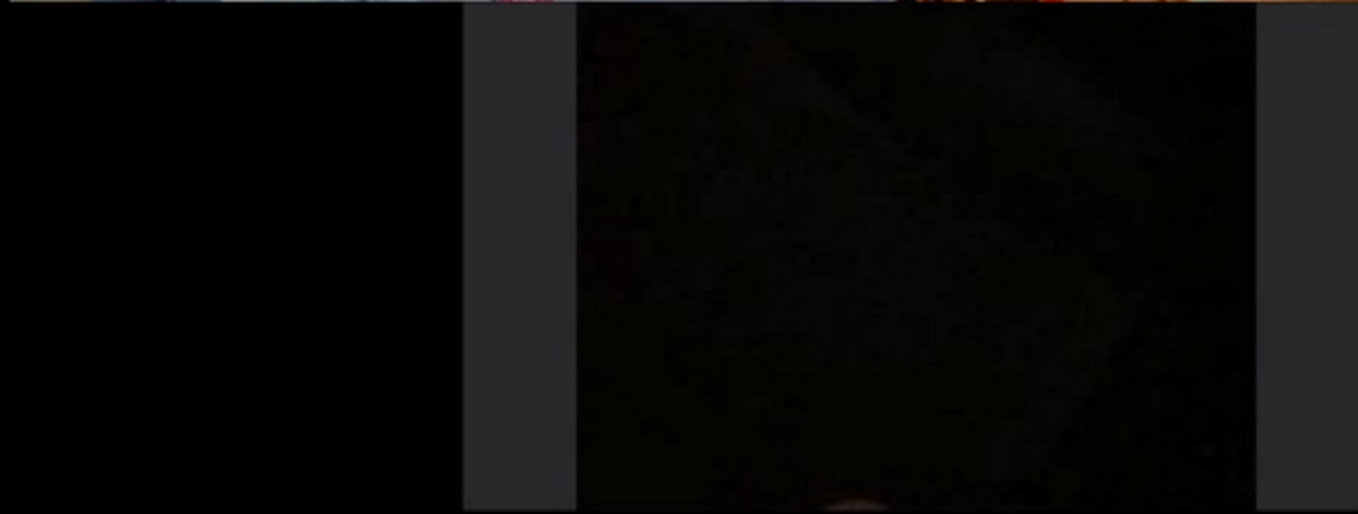
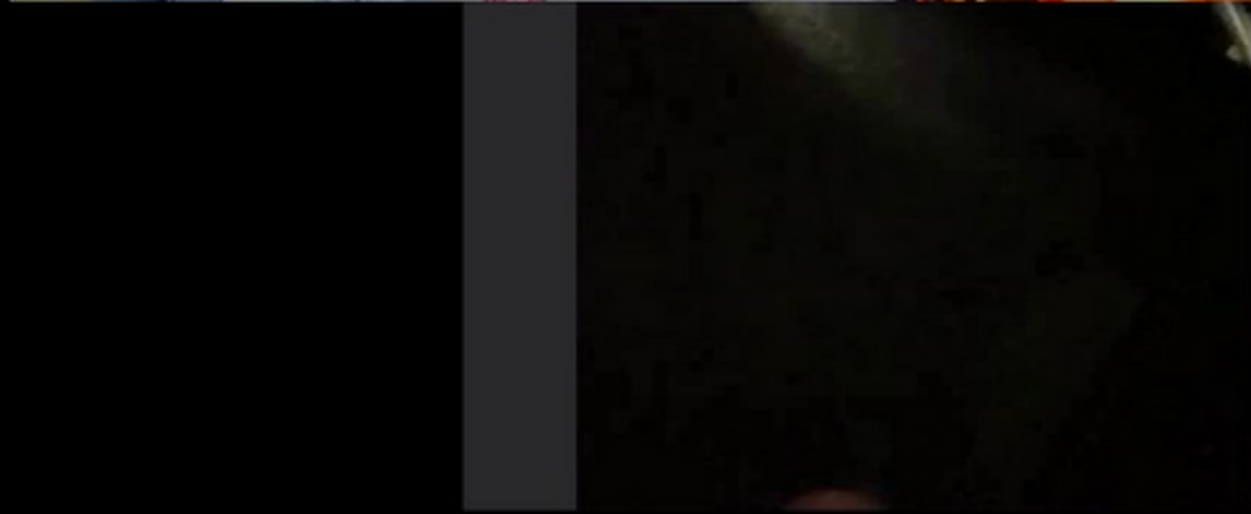


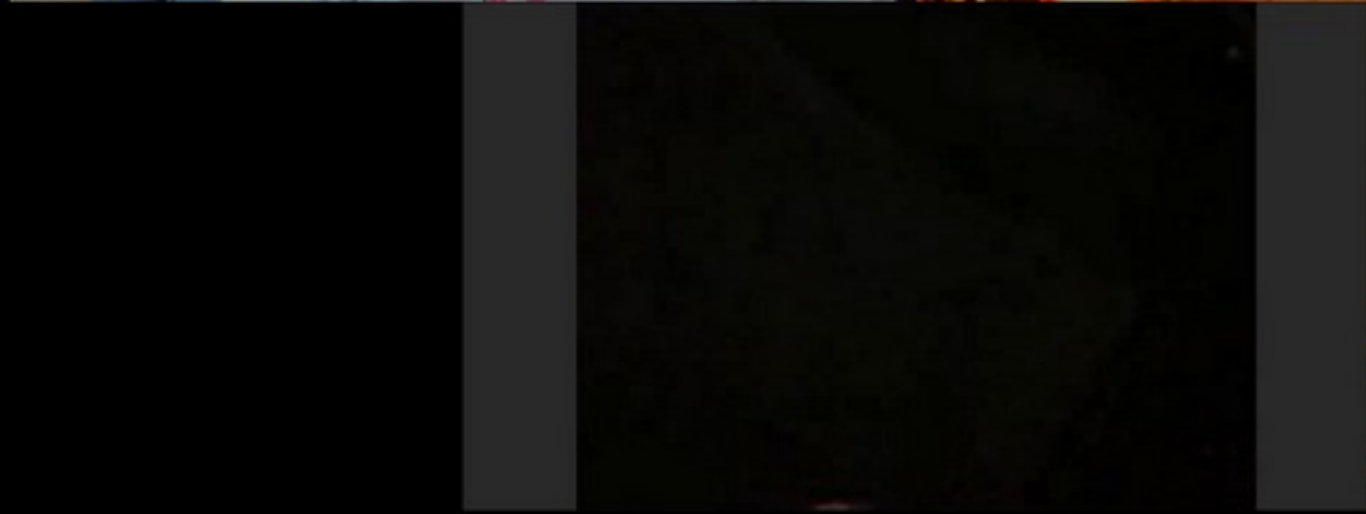
# Business Agenda

    - Vendors – Comments on timing to solicit for vendors? How late is too late?









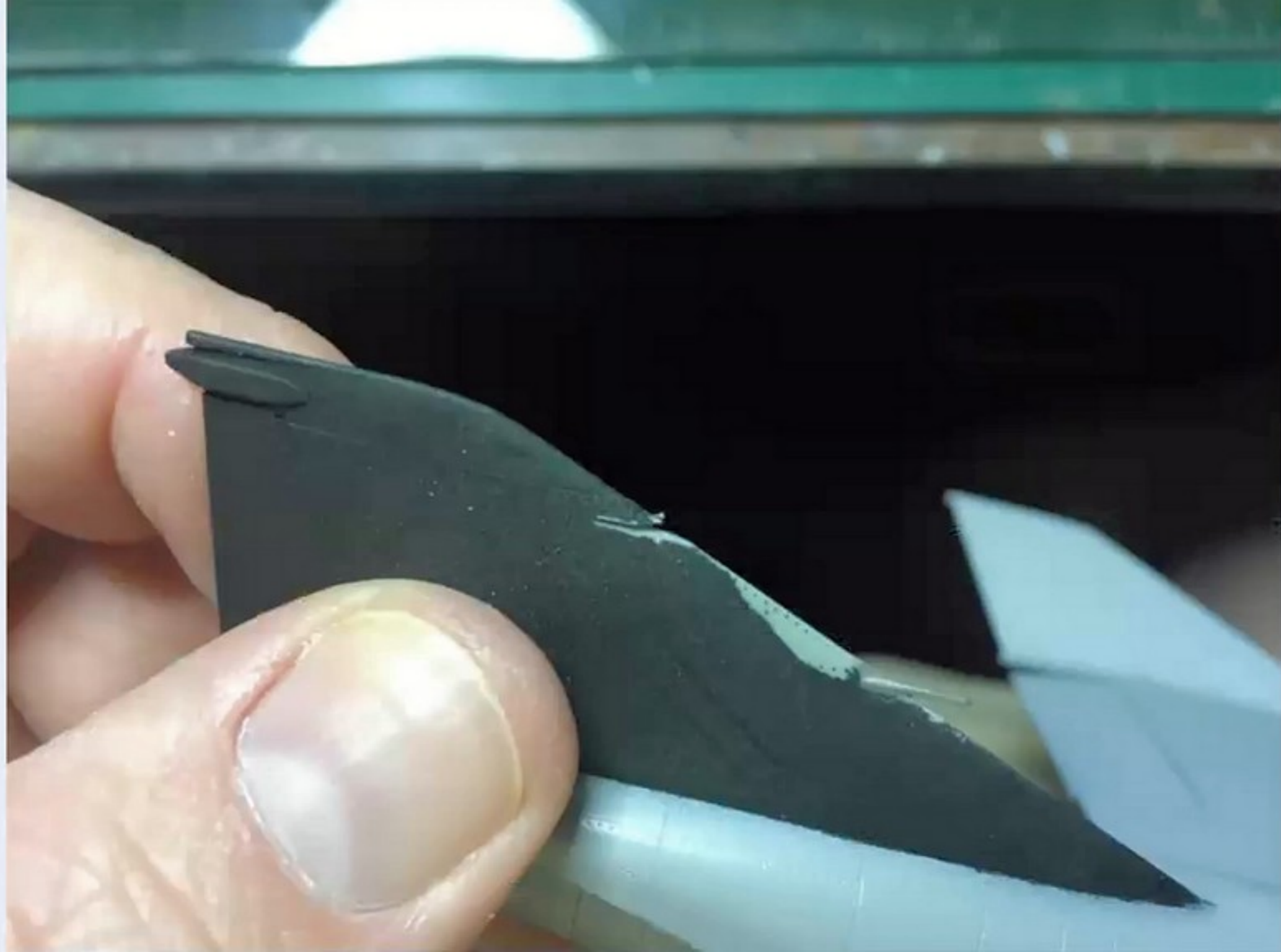




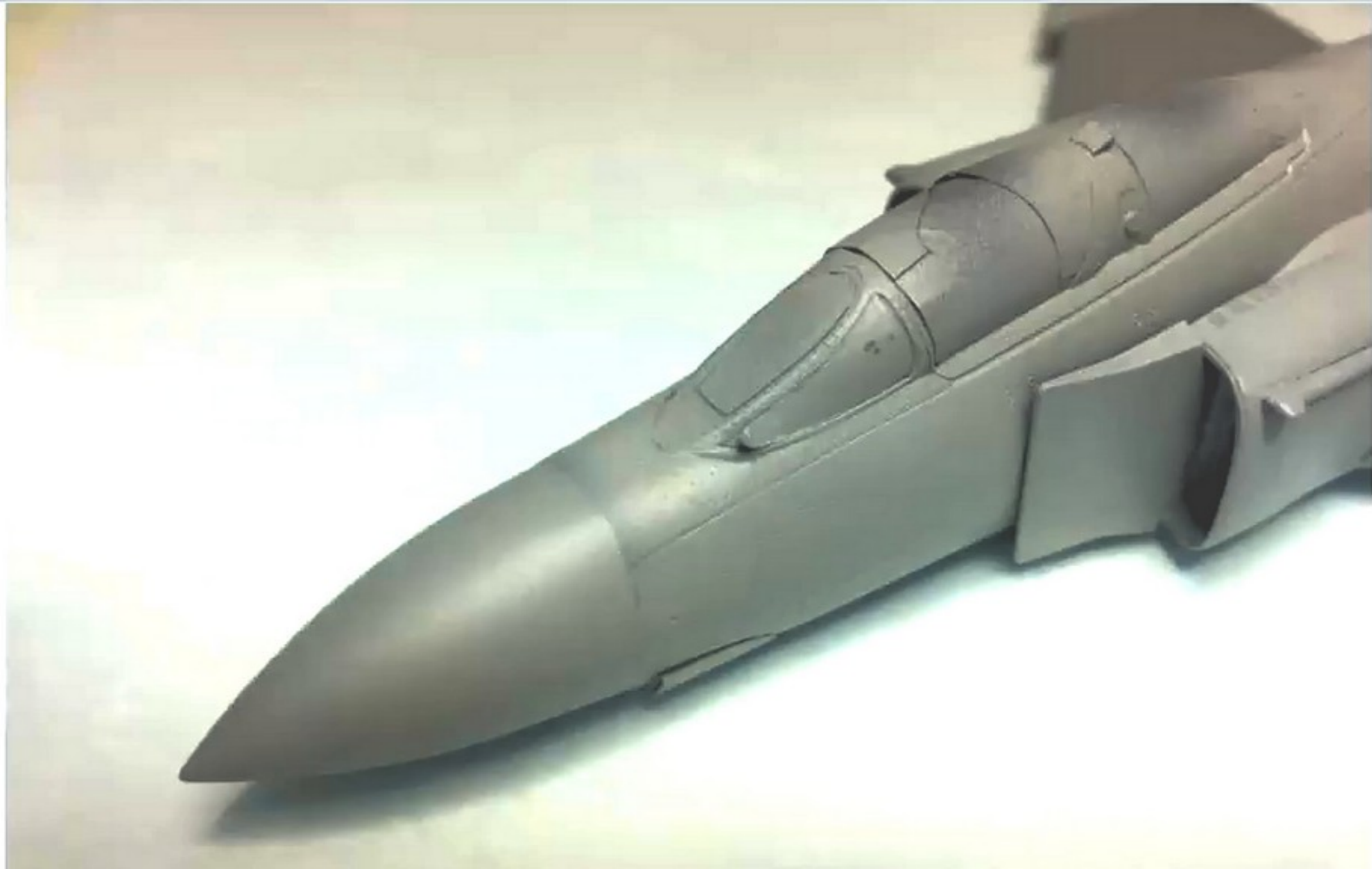




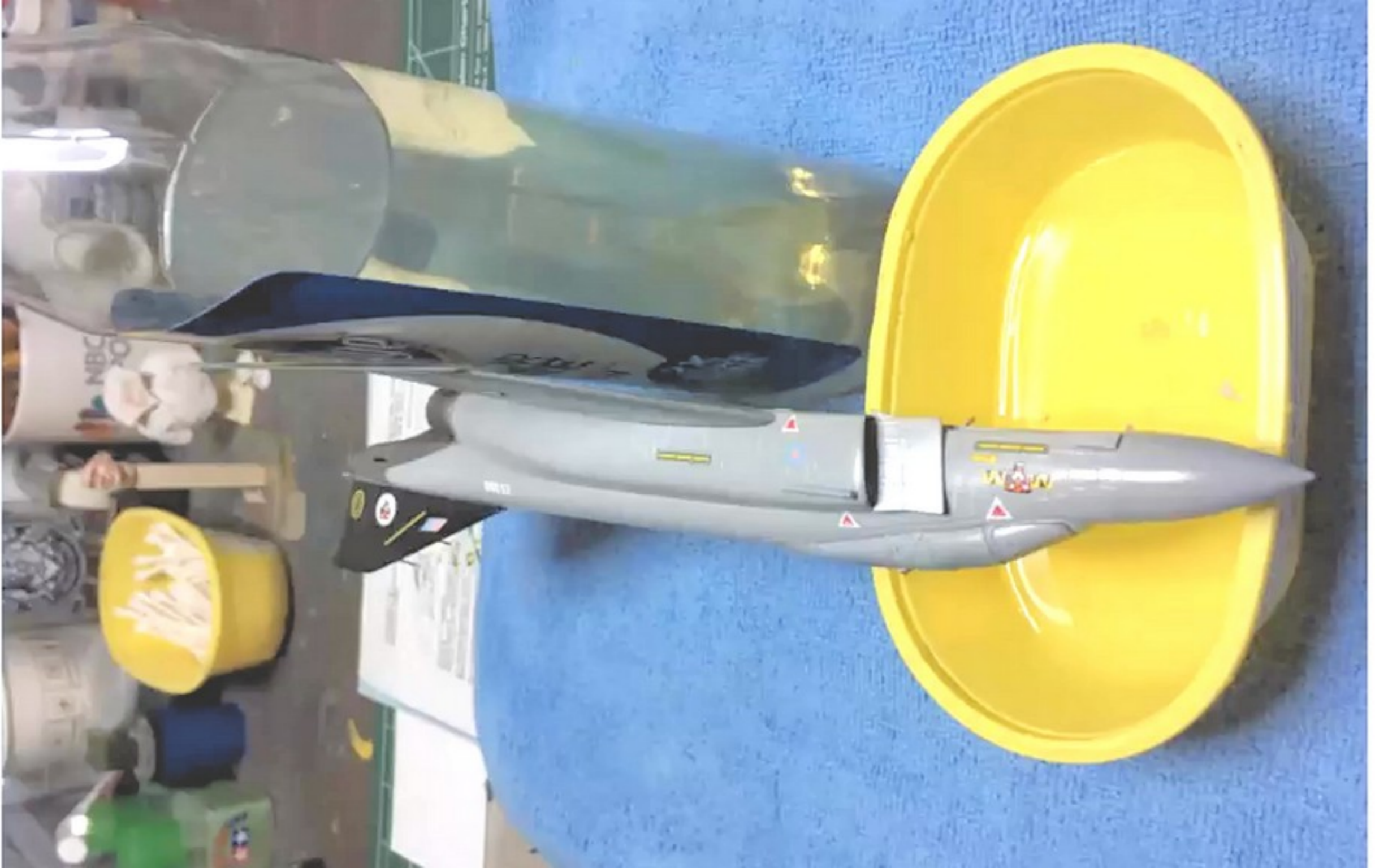




































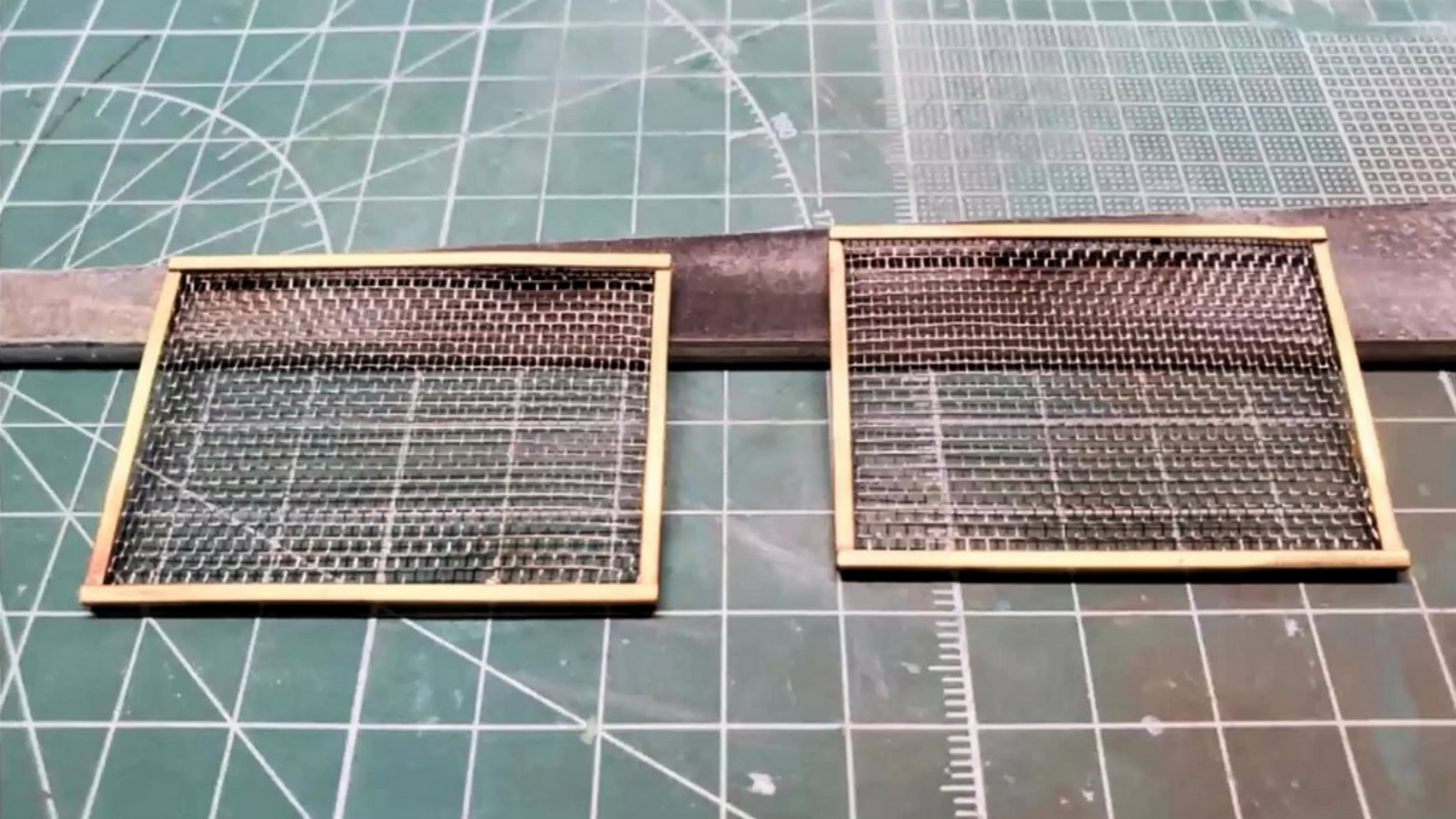


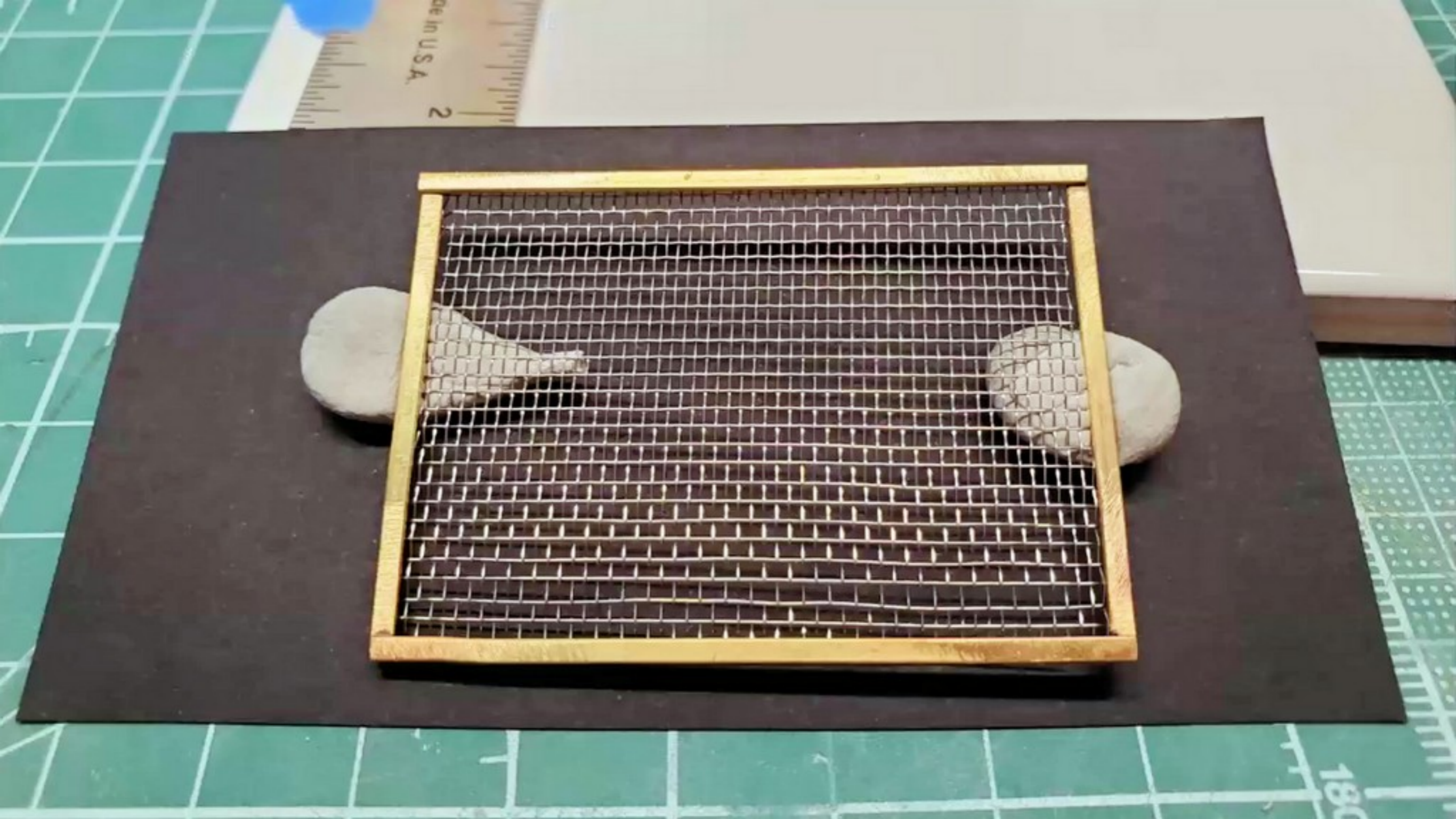
