Continuing south to California's redwood country, **travel through Redwood National Park**, home to trees that can reach nearly 300 feet. See for yourself why the sun seldom hits the ground. Day 6: Eureka - San Francisco

Next, **drive over the legendary Golden Gate Bridge and arrive in "the City by the Bay," San Francisco**.
