Check the website for giving opportunities. During Lent focus for giving will be on toilet paper, diapers, and hygiene products to be taken to the pantry. Mission team does not have a chair now, will meet in March to see what the team will come up with.

Garden- Karen Miglioretto reported that the garden plots are full. Garden will be having 2 weekends in March to clean up and begin preparing the garden to be planted. Looking at repairing some of the wood on the garden plots

40-year Anniversary- The team looked over the ideas that Larry McClure has brainstormed. List is comprehensive and daunting.
