Key: Bb+ I vii I

b) the scale with the leading note of C

Key: Db+ I vii I

c) the scale with the dominant of Db

Key: Gb+ I vii I

d) the scale with the KS of 3 flats

Key: Eb+ I vii I

2. Write the following scales with key signatures descending in the bass clef.

Label the Dominant and Leading note.

a) the scale with a KS of 4 flats

b) the scale with a leading note of E

Key: F+ vii V

c) the scale with the leading note of Bb
