Are you a Unisonoric or Bisonoric Accordionist?

The action of your bellows produces notes, or pitches, by moving air through the reeds.

A key or button on a **unisonoric** accordion produce the same pitch regardless of the direction of the bellow action.

When depressing one button on a **bisonoric** accordion, however, two different notes can be played—one note when the bellows is pulled out, and another, different note when the bellows is pushed in.
