The Cumberland County DOC meeting has been suspended due to unavailability of presenters due to personal matters. They were receptive to having the facility made available as circumstances change. I wish to take this opportunity to advise the Area Service Committee that I will not be a candidate to chair the subcommittee beyond the end of this year's tenure. I wish to thank the subcommittee members for their help and participation over the past 3 years. Thank you for allowing me to serve.

SHARING SESSION:
