### Open Enrollment at CCA is Limited

Iowa Open Enrollment rules allow for parents and guardians to enroll their child in a public school other than their district of residence. However, school boards may adopt a policy to limit open enrollment if space is an issue in their district. There are also deadlines that apply to all open enrollments.

The deadline for a kindergarten student is September 1 of the school year of enrollment; for all other students it is March 1 the school year preceding enrollment.

Due to space limitations at some of the Clear Creek Amana centers, open enrollment for the 2022 school year is allowed at the Amana Elementary and the CCA High School. Enrollment is closed at the Clear Creek (Oxford), North Bend, Tiffin and Oak Hill Elementary and the CCA Middle School. Also due to space limitations open enrollment will not be accept after the deadline in the CCA District.
