The following events and improvements took place in Menominee Township in 2018:

Experienced \$2,865,562 worth of new construction

O-1 Drive, Bay De Noc Drive, and part of Fairland Loop were paved and shouldered. 6.25 Lane was covered with limestone. The Township spent a total of \$286,776 on improvements and maintenance of roads this year.

Michelle Shepeck is our new custodian.

Keith Kovar is our new sexton.

Completed the new circle drive and parking lot in the park. This improvement should help a lot with traffic flow and safety issues.
