Ordinance No. 8

To regulate the powers and duties of village marshals and policemen.

The village council of the village of New Munich do ordain as follows:—

Section One.

It shall be the duty of the marshal and chief police and all regular and special policemen of said village of New Munich, and they and each of them are hereby authorized and empowered to maintain and preserve the public peace within said village, and without warrant to arrest any person found violating any criminal law of the state, or any ordinance of the village of New Munich, and bring such offender before the justices of said village to answer to the charge of preferred against them, and each of said officers shall have power to serve, within said village of New Munich, any process issued by either of the justices of said village, in any action, civil or criminal, arising or found upon any ordinance of said village.

Section II:—

Any village policeman or village marshal shall act in the capacity of Fire Warden of the village of New Munich, and may at any and all times examine and inspect any stove pipe, chimney, flue, furnace, fireplace, oven or smoke house in said village whenever he deems such examination necessary for the safety of any property in said village, and when found dangerous shall order the owner, owners, occupants, or occupants to put the same in a safe condition, and any person or persons when notified, who shall refuse or neglect for the term of three days to comply with said order, shall be subject to a fine not less than One nor more than twenty Dollars, besides the costs of prosecution,

Section III:

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
