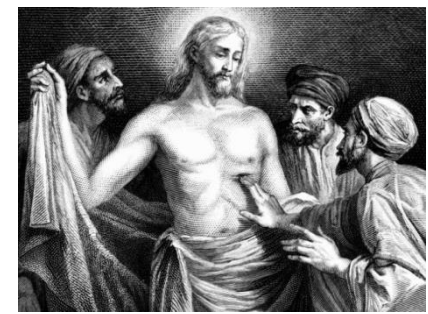

| <b>General Information</b>         | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• He was a twin. (John 20:24)</li><li>• Listed as one of Christ’s twelve disciples. (Matt 10:2-4; Mark 3:16-19; Luke 6:14-16)</li></ul>   |
| <b>Personality &amp; Character</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Inquisitive. (John 14:5)</li><li>• Doubtful. (John 20:24, 25)</li><li>• Courageous. (John 11:16)</li><li>• Faithful. (John 20:24-29)</li></ul>  |
| <b>Encounters with Jesus</b>       | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Courageously encouraged disciples to go to Bethany. (John 11:16)</li><li>• Asked Jesus how to know where Jesus was going. (John 14:5)</li><li>• Doubted Jesus’ resurrection saying he would have to touch his wounds in order to believe. (John 20:25)</li><li>• Affirmed that Jesus was Lord and God. (John 20:28)</li><li>• Witnessed the miraculous catch of fish and ate breakfast with Jesus after his resurrection. (John 21:2-7)</li></ul> |
| <b>Key Lesson</b>                  | Jesus can overcome doubts and lead believers in faithfulness.   |
| <b>Stories</b>                     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Stories suggest that Thomas traveled to India and founded the Christian church there.</li><li>• Some suggest Thomas was killed by a spear for his faith and was buried in India.</li><li>• Some say Thomas was a carpenter.</li><li>• Symbols for Thomas include the spearhead and the T-square.</li></ul>  |
