

Annual Catholic Appeal Rooted in Faith: Moving Forward With Love

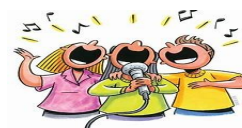
