USBC GREATER BOSTON 2019 YOUTH TOURNAMENT

ELIGIBILITY

- The GBUSBC Youth City Tournament will be bowled in accord with USBC rules.
- All entrants must be USBC Certified and members of the Greater Boston USBC.
- 3. Entrants must use their highest USBC certified League average of 21 games or more as of January 1, 2019. If they do not have an established average by January 1, 2019, they must have 21 games in by March 2, 2019

EVENTS

- 4. There will be Team (4 person), Doubles and Singles event
- 5. An entrant may bowl on different Teams provided no more than 2 bowlers of a Team combine to form another team.
- Entrants will be automatically be entered into handicap and scratch divisions
- Each event will be 3 games with total pin fall including handicap deciding the winners. Duplicate awards will be given in the event of a tie.
- 8. Handicaps will be based on 90% of the difference between bowler's average and 220
- Entrants who bowl in all events (Team, Doubles & Singles) and pay the \$ 4.00 All Events fee will compete for the awards based on total in the all events.
- An entrant's FIRST score bowled in each of the 3 events will be used for the All Events Total.

SUBSTITUTES

- Substitutes must be made at least 1 hour before the scheduled bowling time and must be eligible bowlers as defined above.
- Substitutes must bowl in the position of the bowler they are replacing.
- After a game has been started, in the event of an emergency, a substitute may be allowed if one is available.
- If the average of the substitute changes the handicap, the handicap automatically will be changed.
- The substitute shall not be required to pay an entry fee and may receive and keep their individual share of awards.

REPORTING

- All Team Captains, Doubles Partners, and Singles entrants should sign in at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time and must present their Membership Cards upon registering.
- 17. A tardy bowler shall receive a ZERO (0) for each frame missed and will begin bowling in the frame being bowled at the time

<u>AWAR</u>DS

- 18. There will be TWO DIVISIONS by AVERAGE: 139 & below and 140 & above.
- 19. Awards will be given in both Handicap and Scratch Categories in each Division. One (1) award will be given for every six (6) entries in each division provided that there are at least four (4) entries in each event. Awards will be awarded in each division for each event.
- 20. Awards shall be given for All EVENTS in each division in a one (1) in ten (10) ratio with a minimum of six (6) entries per division.
- 21. When an entrant wins twice in the same category, they will receive one (1) award with both listing on the plate.

GENERAL

- 22. The "USBC YOUTH CODE" will be strictly enforced for this Tournament. No food or beverages will be allowed in the playing area. The use of cell phones, IPods, etc., will NOT be allowed while participating in the Tournament. No resin or foreign substance will be allowed on the lanes, approaches, or for use on a ball or shoes.
- 23. Only participants and Tournament Officials will be allowed in the playing area. NO COACHING WILL BE ALLOWED DURING THE TOURNAMENT!!! PENALTY: Junior Bowler can be disqualified from the Tournament.
- Proper dress required collared shirts or bowling shirts. Tournament
 officials will determine proper attire. NO HATS to be worn by
 participants during the Tournament.
- 25. The Tournament Director will settle all disputes and complaints. Protests must be submitted in WRITING to the Tournament Director with- in 48 HOURS of such protested event and will be decided upon by the Greater Boston USBC (GBUSBC) Board of Directors.
- 26. Any changes in the entries must be made with the Tournament Director at least 30 minutes prior to bowling time.
