New Big Leaf: Design with Freezer Paper Templates Level confident beginner, intermediate, advanced

Description

Make this large graphic leaf, using freezer paper to form the design templates. The final 24" x 24" piece is a great wall hanging, or you can add additional blocks to make a stunning quilt. This is a great workshop for learning to work confidently in color, as well as learning the easy method of using freezer paper templates for construction.

Materials

This is a great quilt for using your accumulated scraps. Use small amounts (1/4 yards are great or fat quaters) of fabrics in a range of colors that go from light to dark. Please don't bring whole yards or large amounts! Batiks, solids, or textures work well, smaller scale commercial prints are fine, too. Hand-dyes are wonderful to use, as well as wild graphics. Add small amounts (1/8 yard or so) of neon or bright fabric like lime green or fuchsia if you have it on hand.

Basic sewing supplies, rotary cutter, pins, scissors, sewing machine with regular foot (not a ¼" foot) Seam ripper, ruler, etc.

Colored pencils in at least 3 colors, sharpie medium point permanent marker, highlighter at least 5 running feet of freezer paper

Large cutting matt (like 24" x 36")
