

Treasurer's Update:

Dear Aldersgate Family,


I hope this message finds you well. I wanted to share some important updates about our financial situation.

Our Capital Campaign is still underway, following expenses for air conditioning and roof repairs. As of December 31st, \$13,160 of the \$26,960 borrowed from the Memorial Fund has been raised.

This past year, Aldersgate's income exceeded expenses by \$8,039.98. However, without the \$15,000 from parsonage rent, and given that Pastor Tyrek is only part-time, we would have faced a deficit of \$19,460.02 for 2024.

Also, since Pastor Tyrek's position is part-time, the church was not required to contribute towardshis \$4,000 retirement for the six months he has been at Aldersgate. Lastly, AUMC has only met \$21,314.48 of the \$40,341.00 in conference apportionments charged for 2024.

As you can see, the financial situation of Aldersgate is quite serious when viewed in its entirety. So please remain steadfast in your giving and keep our church in your prayers. Together, we can ensure Aldersgate's continued vitality.

Do you like the "renewed" look of the Aldersgate United Methodist Church's small and large parking lots? Do you appreciate how beautiful, clean, and welcoming they now appear?
