

**PROGRESS CONTINUES TO BE MADE ON PRAYER SHRINE DEDICATED TO THE MYSTERIES OF THE ROSARY**

*El Santuario de Los Pobladores – The Sanctuary of the Settlers, under the leadership of Alfonzo Abeyta, board member, and the cooperation of its members have been working very hard this past summer making adobes to get the shrine project going. We invite supporters of this undertaking to stop by the site to see the progress made. Adobe walls fashioned by hard work and zealous determination have gone up and completed. Adding additional warmth and appeal, a large beautiful rustic gate is adorning the entrance to the shrine with three smaller gates at the exits. Bronze art for the individual nichos has also been completed and will be mounted next spring.*

*At the entrance to the shrine, there will be an 8 foot bronze statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Seven surrounding bronze statues of our mission patron saints will bolster the spiritual presence of our faith. Adobe dedication plaques and merchant donor plaques will also be in place. Landscaping and a security system will complete the project. The committee estimates that additional funds to complete the project will be approximately \$250,000. The board of El Santuario is deeply grateful for your support of our work with your donations and prayers.*

## THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

**Bless the Lord, O my soul!  
O Lord my God, you are very great!**

*You are clothed with splendor and majesty,  
covering yourself with light as with a garment,

**Theme: The Servant of Yahweh**

**Every time we discover a new aspect in one we love, we stop in wonderment. “I did not know him/her as such!” And this deeper insight and sharing in a person’s self results in greater appreciation, intimacy, and love. Today we celebrate the Lord’s baptism by John in the Jordan. Luke relates Jesus’ baptism as another epiphany (manifestation), declaring that the Lord Jesus is the Son of Yahweh.**

**Jesus as Shepherd (First Reading) gives us a deeper insight into who our Lord is. He is “the man who cares for others.” He is there for you and me. Experiencing this in prayer, we should appreciate and love our Lord more for it.**

**All of us have our own calling in life. We must respond to it in the framework of our personal capabilities and the circumstances of time and milieu. Serious and mature people understand that only a life of service is a meaningful life. What do you consider you main calling in life, and how do you fulfill it? “Almighty ever-living God, . . .grant that your children by adoption, reborn of water and the Holy Spirit, may always be will pleasing to you” (Collect).
