

Fortunately, there is nothing like indisputable facts and original source material to crystallize a point. In that regard, we offer some of the very best resources (*below*), including Mohammad's own devastating words, to help you sort through the thousands of publications that shed a critical light on the true teachings of Islam. At the very least, you should study the first few and then work through the others to round out your knowledge and add to your toolbox of resources you will need to spread the word with credibility.

*Note: If you haven't already learned it in previous lessons, it is critical at this point for you to understand that Islam's holy books (Quran/Hadith) were written at different times and by different people. For example, do not be confused when others try to quote a peaceful- sounding verse from the Qur'an and then claim you must be wrong.*

*When Mohammad was a peaceful person when first attempting to start his new "religion" in Mecca, he wrote a portion of the Qur'an without hate. After he was rejected and his "religion" failed to gain any significant number of followers after ten (10) years, he moved to Medina and became a ruthless warlord, at which time the ranks of Islam soared as all those that disagreed were eliminated through violence. The peaceful verses that he wrote in Mecca were considered to be [abrogated](#) by later violent verses written in Medina as Mohammad shifted his ministry from peacemaking to terrorism. Today, you see the results of that strategic change as evidenced by the [Tears of Jihad](#) in a 1400 year reign of intimidation and terror.*
