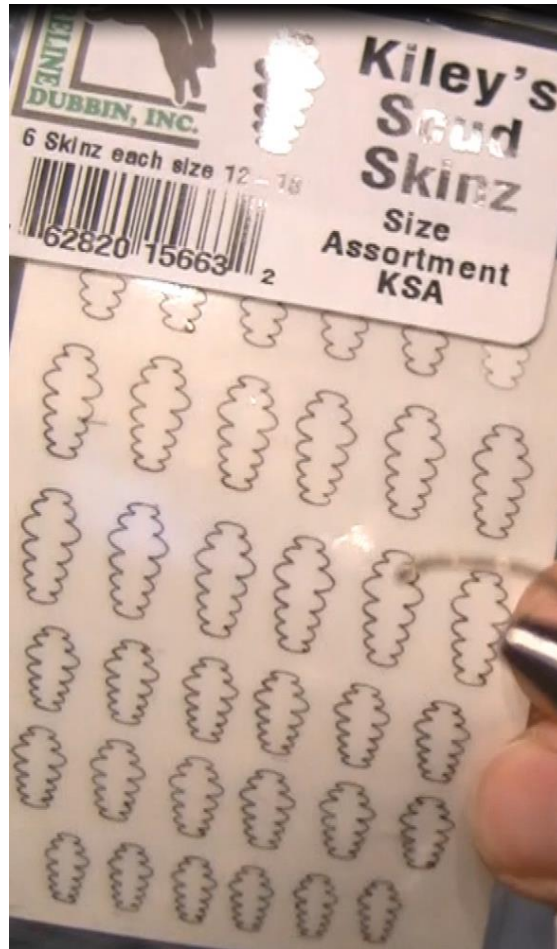


## Kiley's Scud Skinz





**Recipe:**

**Hook:** Scud Hook TMC2487 sizes 12-18

**Thread:** Mono

**Tail and Antenna:** Coq De Leon

**Rib:** UTC Silver Small or X-Small wire

**Body:** Dubbing to match color of scud

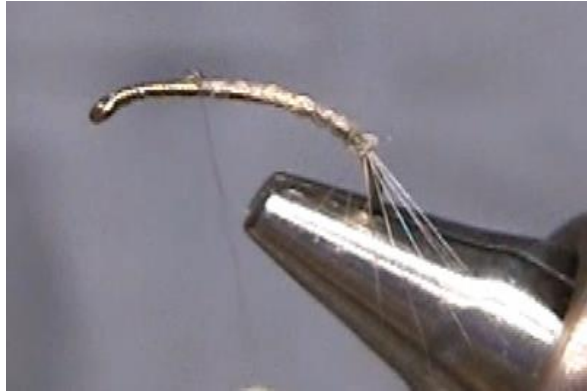
**Hotspot:** UV Shrimp Ice Dub

**Scud Back:** Kiley's Scud Skinz

**Eyes:** Black Sharpie

**Coating:** Loon UV

1. Attach the thread to the hook and leave the thread at the bend of the hook.
2. Attach the Coq De Leon Tails (5-6 Fibers). Wrapping down around the bend of the hook and then back to 75% of the hook shank. Tails should be  $\frac{3}{4}$  to a hook shank long.



3. Attach the Coq De Leon (5-6 Fibers) antenna to the front of the hook. The tips will point out over the hook eye. Antenna should be about half a hook shank in length.
4. Tie in the UTC Silver wire for the rib. Leave the thread at the tail.



5. Dub the body. Use extra Dubbing to compensate for the legs being picked out when the fly is finished. Stop at the center of the Fly.

- Dub the Hot Spot using the UV Shrimp Ice Dub. This spot will be about 20% of the fly.



- Finish dubbing using the original color



- Pull a Scud Skinz from the sheet. Press the Scud Skinz in place on the Back of the fly.



9. Wrap the UTC Silver wire forward using the notches in the Scud Skinz as a guide. Tie off behind the Hook Eye and trim the wire.



10. Whip Finish.

11. Use a Black Sharpie to add eyes at the hook bend.



12. Use a Bodkin or small blade to pull dubbing fibers for the legs.



13. Apply Loon UV to the Scud Skinz along the back and sides. Cure with UV light.
