Tournament Guideline and Rules

Cornhole Boards and bags

- Adults 18 and over the boards will be placed 27 feet apart (front to front).
- The front of the Cornhole platform shall be from 2-1/2" inches from bottom to top and be at near a 90-degree angle to the deck face.
- Boards must measure 2'X4'
- The back of the Cornhole platform shall be 12 inches from ground to the highest point of the deck at a 90-degree angle to the deck face.
- The Cornhole / Corn Toss play surface may be painted with a high gloss latex paint resulting in a surface that allows corn bags to slide but is not so slippery that it allows the bags to slide back down the platform.

Points System

- 3 Points for a cornhole bag that goes through the hole.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is hanging into the hole.
- 1 Point for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the edge but not touching the ground.
- 0 Points for a cornhole bag that is on the playing surface but is also touching the ground.
- 0 Points for a cornhole bag that is hanging off the front edge and is resting on a cornhole bag that is on the ground. However, if you can remove the bag on the ground without the one on the board falling, then a point is given.

Scoring

1. The team with the highest round score adds the difference of the two scores to its game score.
2. The team that wins the round is given honors to throw first in the next round.
3. If both cornhole teams have the same round score then the game score stays the same and honors stay with the team who had it the previous round.
4. A team earns 3 points for cornhole bags that go into the hole. They must go completely into the hole. Bags that are hanging in the hole count only 1 point. If an opponent knocks your bag into the hole you still get the 3 points.

Cornhole Fouls

1. A cornhole player's foot goes past the foot foul line. (front of the cornhole board)
2. A player goes out of turn.

3. The throw the foul occurs on is voided. If the bag is on the board, it is removed.

Game Play

1. In doubles play partners shall stand at opposite cornhole boards.

2. Each cornhole team will have 4 bags of one color.

3. All 8 cornhole bags begin at one end.

4. Each game will be played with 4 players (2 teams).

5. Opponents' alternate tosses until all 8 bags are played.

6. The team who has honors will begin play by throwing a cornhole bag at the opposite cornhole board.

7. A cornhole player may throw from either side of the board but must stay on that side for the entire round.

8. If a cornhole bag hits the ground then bounces up onto the board, remove that bag for it does not count.

9. Count the points scored during the round. If no team has reached the 21 point mark start the next round until a team reaches 21. The team that scores the highest number of points on the previous round will have honors. No bags shall be touched until both teams agree on that round's score.

10. The first team to accumulate 21 or more points wins the game! That team will advance to the next round. The losing team is eliminated from the tournament.

11. The score is the difference in the teams' totals. For example: After 1 round or 8 bags played, Team #1 has thrown 1 bag into the hole and 3 off the board; their total then is 3 points. Team #2 has thrown 1 bag on the board and 3 off the board; their total then is 1 point. Subtract Team #2's score from Team #1's and the total score for the round is Team #1 earns 2 points.

12. To start each match the teams will be allowed one free round to warm up for the game.

13 All decisions of the SMF Cornhole Tournament Committee are final. Violations of any rules or regulations may result in a team being disqualified.

15. The tournament is limited to the first **32 teams** to register and pay entry fees

16. Bracket seeding will be completed using a blind draw.

17. Any team not ready for play will be eliminated from the tournament. The opposing team will advance to the next round. If neither team is available, both will be eliminated.

18. The Tournament will begin at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 29, 2017 TEAMS NEED TO BE AT BOOTH AT 10:30AM.

19. The Tournament location will be at the tri county fairgrounds **(subject to change due to inclement weather)**

20. Entry fee is **non – refundable** for any teams that are not present when games begin and will be disqualified. (Please look on entry form for times)
