VESSEL SAFETY CHECK—JUNE 8 10AM-2PM

On Saturday June 8th, from 10am to 2pm, KYC will host a Vessel Safety Check (VSC) Event. Certified vessel examiners from both the US Coast Guard Auxiliary and the United States Power Squadron will perform a **free** VSC at your boat. Sailboats and power boats are both eligible and the boat does not need to be in the water. Power boats must have a charged battery connected in order to receive a VSC. There is no charge and *no consequence* if your boat doesn't pass. The goal is simply to help make boating as safe as possible for you, your family, and friends. Boats that pass will receive a certificate which may entitle you to a discount on your boat insurance.

To make sure we have enough inspectors it will be helpful to know how many boats we expect to attend. **Please email me if you are interested and are likely to attend.** Also, please feel free to reach out if you have any questions.

My thanks to the US Coast Guard Auxiliary, United States Power Squadron and the Keuka Lake Association for their help putting this together.
