NOVEMBER 1, 2016

1. Meeting called to order by Chairman Dwight Gordon with the following members present: Clifton Deloach, Gerald Blocker, Willie Frank Thompson and Robert Long.
2. Meeting led in prayer by Mr. Long.
3. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to accept minutes for October 2016. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. Deloach voted yea.
4. Motion made by Mr. Deloach, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to table the Sheriff's Dept vehicles to the Department Heads meeting on November 13, 2016. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.
5. Motion made by Mr. Deloach, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to add and item to the agenda which was previously left off for the betterment of Long County. (mosquito control) Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Thompson voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
6. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to adopt the Munic Code Ordinance for Long County. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. Thompson voted yea.

Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to adopt the Ordinance to hereby declared to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety an welfare of the people of the County of Long, and is hereby ordered to give immediate effect from and after the date of its passage.

10. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Long to hire Soumaila Sabir for the position of full time cook at the Senior Center effective 11-2-16. He will have 90 day probation period. Mr. Gordon voted yea, Mr. Blocker voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.

11. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to table the part time cook position to the next meeting. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.
12. Motion made by Mr. Long, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to hire William Crowley for the position of part time driver at the Senior Center to deliver the meals effective 11-2-16. He will have 90 day probation period. Mr. Gordon voted yea, Mr. Blocker voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.
