

Ohio's new Healthy Aging Grants program is empowering Ohioans to thrive as they age. We are excited to announce that Hocking County has received funds from Ohio's Healthy Aging Grant. We will be using these funds to support food assistance services, support housing assistance, support digital literacy as well as improving: community conditions, healthy living, access to care, social connectedness, and preserving independence. This is intended for seniors in need. See page 7 for details.



Hocking County Board of Commissioners/Scenic Hills Senior Center has received a Healthy Aging Grant through the Department of Aging to serve in the Hocking County Region.

In order to utilize the grant, you will need to write your birthdate and signature for documentation, be age 60+, in need and reside in Hocking County.

The requirements of the grant are to be used as followed:

- 1). 20% of the total Grant needs to used for allocating and support of food assistance services.
- A. With these funds we have come up with a plan to serve both hot meals and shelf stable foods to our senior population. We have a contract with (2) local restaurants (The Feed and M&M Diner) for hot meals. Seniors may go to one of the restaurants and request one meal one time per week. You may only receive one meal and the value cannot exceed \$20.00. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
- **B**. Seniors may go to Carpenters Mini Mart to pick up a \$100.00 frozen food box with beef, pork and chicken (boxes are pre-made and cannot be substituted). Boxes will only be given out on Mondays and a total of 10 boxes per week. **Only one box per household.** These are limited once they are gone we cannot extend this offer.
- **C.** We will be offering Free Nutritional Bingo every Thursday starting on March 21st. Participants will receive a sack of fresh fruit and vegetables along with boxed and canned food. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
- **D.** We will have Emergency Food Supply for those in need by calling 740.385.6581. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
- E. We will have monetary vouchers for Walmart and Kroger. (\$50 single/\$100 for couples)

 Only one gift card per household. These will be available at the senior center located at 187

 S. Spring Street. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
- 2). 20% of the total Grant needs to be used for support of housing assistance and legal services.
 - A. The largest portion of these funds will be used to contract with Good Care for home modification assistance. This includes ramps, grab bars for restrooms, sidewalks and other home repairs. All requests need to call Scenic Hills Senior Center at 740.385.6581 and speak with the executive director, Marjie Moore. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
 - **B.** We have gone into contract with attorneys Drew Rolston and Stephen Proctor for free advanced directive for seniors such as wills, power of attorney and healthcare power of attorney. You will need to call the law office for appointments at 740.385.5604 and let them know you're requesting the Healthy Aging Grant for this service. Once funds have been depleted we cannot extend this offer.
- 3). 10% of the total grant needs to be used for technology literacy assistance
 - A. We will be purchasing 3 iPads for both the Educational and Wellness Center and the Senior Center locations for use by the seniors. The iPads will have downloads of mind, word and other memory comprehensive items to keep seniors sharp and help with memory.
 - B. We will offer free technology assistance with computers, cellphones, security, internet, Facebook, email, etc. We will be partnering with the Logan-Hocking County Library. Assistance will be available at the Spring Street location every Thursday from 9:30 10:30 a.m. Assistance will be available at the Laurelville library the second Wednesday of every month from 10:00 11:00 a.m.


The remainder of the funds will be used to help with chore service, fitness classes, support transportation, grocery shopping, delivery of food boxes, home medical equipment, etc.
