INVITATION TO ATTEND

Please join us for the 2016 Wyoming Archaeological Society (WAS) Summer Meeting, again at the Hell Gap site. We invite you to participate in the investigation of one of North America's most significant Paleoindian localities – and a site owned by the WAS's Wyoming Archaeological Foundation. Activities are planned for Saturday and Sunday morning. Please plan to arrive by the evening of Friday the 29th or before if you wish to volunteer. A volunteer form (last page) is encouraged if you plan to work.

Activities planned for this summer's meeting include:

- Tours of the ongoing archaeology and the Hell Gap valley.
- Participation in excavations for those who wish to dig or work in the lab.
- Site maintenance for those wishing to assist the WAF in upkeep of the facilities.
- Atl-atl throw (bring your own equipment' Wyoming Atl-atl and social club and Russel Richard)
- Flintknapping demonstration by Larry Langford, Bill Beekman of Denver, Michael Peterson, and others)
- Hang out and enjoy the Hartville Uplift scenery
- Visit to Sunrise and Powers II site (George Frison and George Zeimens)
- Evening pot luck

Other optional activities on your own while coming and going, visits to:

- Agate Fossil Beds National Monument (in Nebraska).
- Historic Fort Laramie (nearby in Wyoming).
- Western History Center in Lingle (nearby in Wyoming).
- Historic Fort Robinson (in Nebraska).
- Hudson-Meng, Alberta age bison bone bed (in Nebraska).

The Hell Gap site is less than half an hour from Ft. Laramie National Monument, the Oregon Trail ruts, and Register Cliff; and a several hour drive from Agate Fossil Beds National Monument, Fort Robinson, and the Hudson-Meng site. Agate Fossil Beds contains first class ethnographic collections. Come and see all the historic and prehistoric sites near Guernsey all in one visit.

The WAS Hell Gap property has plenty of room for camping. Camping amenities include water from our well and a wonderful shower stall for those who love solar showers! Please plan to provide your own meat and a side dish to share for a barbeque/goat roast on Saturday night the 30th. Nearby Guernsey has several motels for the non-campers, but book early. The road into the site is a graded county gravel road that even passenger cars can manage easily.
