## SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES October 10, 2017

Mayor Reames called the Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

- Purpose: To review a zoning amendment change request filed by Mr. Brad Beatley for property located at 304 Taylor Street and adjacent parcels currently in a B-2 District. The applicant is requesting a zoning district change to B-3.

Mr. Brown described the proposed changes to the zoning districts and explained that this will reduce the business restrictions within the district. Ms. Gauder explained the process of notification to property owners within and around the proposed district change. The village has not received any correspondence from residents opposing the change.

The Planning Commission has recommended to council that the zoning amendment be granted without modification and the Ohio Director of Transportation has no objections to the change.

Citizen's Comments:

Ms. Joan Hill: Ms. Hill asked where the ingress/egress will be from the Beatley's property, and if they thought that this would increase traffic on Fairview Ave.

Mr. Beatley indicated that there would be no increase in traffic due to the ingress/egress from U.S. Rt. 33. Mr. Brown added that there is also ingress/egress off Taylor and Seneca Streets as well, and does not foresee any issue of increased traffic on Fairview Ave.

*Mr. John Huffman made a motion to request that legislation be drafted to accept the zoning change from B-2 to B-3. Ms. Marie Hendel seconded the motion.*
