Condition

of Sanction:

- 1. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member Sanction: Coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient In performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the Responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance With this requirement.
- 2. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). The copy Of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- 3. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms is prohibited.
- 4. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

Type of Meet: 25 Yard Course – All events are timed finals.

Meet management may opt to use fly-over starts at this competition. Meet management may also opt to cancel relays due to time constraints.

Meet management may also change number of lanes used for competition based on entries.

Meet management reserves the right, based on number of entries, to combine events, drop events, and/or combine sessions in order to expedite the timeline of the meet.

Start time: 45 minutes after mid-day session, not before 12:30

Session 4 - March 18, 2018

Sunday Morning – 13 & Over Warm-up – 7:30am; Start – 8:30am.

Session 5 - March 18, 2018

Sunday Mid day - 11 & Over

Warm-up - During morning session in extra lanes

Start time: 10 minutes after morning session, not before 11am

Session 6 - March 18, 2018

Sunday Afternoon - 12 & Under

Warm-up – During mid-day session & after session

Start time: 45 minutes after mid-day session, not before 12:30

Eligibility:

Open to all current USA Swimming registered athletes and foreign swimmers with proper travel credentials. On deck registrations will be allowed. 2018 USA-S form and fee must be presented to the Referee. Athletes outside of Area 6 are welcome to compete but will not be scored for Area 6 High Point Championship Awards.

Disability:

Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or entry chairperson must alert the meet director, as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted.

Seeding:

Use 25 Yard Course times. Conversions, using the formula in the current Florida Swimming Handbook may be used for entry and seeding purposes.

Coaches, please consider not submitting an NT time for your athletes. Try to closely estimate each seed time if no time is available so that a more accurate timeline would be created.

* All Events in each session will be seeded BY stroke/distance and swum slowest to fastest EXCEPT for 500 Free and 400 IM which will be seeded Fast to Slow. All events will be scored separately by age group within each fleet (explained in Awards).

Entry Limit:

Swimmers are limited to six (6) events per day.

**Swimmers who have achieved FLAGS or Sr Championships Cuts in an event MAY swim those events at this meet, however they will be scored in their own fleet. Non championship seed times will be scored in their own fleet.

Scratch Penalty: No penalty for scratching at the block unless the following occurs

** IF A SWIMMERS SEED TIME IS CHALLENGED AND IT IS CONFIRMED THAT THEY HAVE A FASTER TIME THAT WOULD HAVE PUT THEM IN A DIFFERENT FLEET FOR SCORING, THEY WILL BE SCRATCHED FROM THAT EVENT AND ALL OTHER EVENTS TIMES FOR THAT SWIMMER WILL BE CHECKED ACCORDINGLY.

Entry Form:

Entries in a Hy-Tek meet entry export file with associated printout should be emailed to meets@brevardswimclub.com.

.Entries not submitted electronically through email will be charged an additional \$50.00 fee. The current USA Swimming registration number must be listed on the hard copy of the meet entries or be in the Hy-Tek meet entry export file. Errors in entries submitted electronically are the responsibility of the applicant. Submission of electronic entries certifies that all entered swimmers are USA Registered.

Entry Fee:

\$10.00 facility fee per swimmer, \$4.15 per individual event and \$5.00 per relay event. Deck entries are \$10.00 for each event plus the \$10.00 facility fee if not already in meet.

Make checks payable to Brevard Swim Club.

Heat Sheets:

There will be a \$2 charge per swimmer for electronic heat sheet. Limited amount of heat sheets will be sold at meet.

Deck Entries:

Deck entries are to be submitted to the Admin Official no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of each session. The fee for deck entries is \$10.00 per individual event. If the swimmer is not already in the meet, the \$10.00 facility fee is also due. Deck entries will only be placed in empty lanes in existing heats and no new heats will be created. Also, heats will not be reseeded for deck entries. Swimmers must still comply with the maximum per session and per day entry limits and other eligibility requirements. Swimmers may not scratch an event to deck enter a new event. Proof of USA Swimming registration must be met.

Distance Events: Positive Check is required for the distance (500 Free and 400 IM). Depending on the number of entries, events may be combined without regard to gender and without regard to empty lanes separating swimmers of opposite gender.

> Seeding will be done after check in and all known scratches are accounted for. If by chance there are no or a limited number of scratches, re-seeding may not take place.

Positive Check In: Events 17-18 and 51-52 are positive check in. All athletes must be checked in by 30 minutes to start of their session. These events will be seeded and swum fast to slow.

Rules: Current USA Swimming Rules will govern the meet. "No Recall" starting procedures in effect. Safety rules

as outlined by USA Swimming and recommended by the Referee will be in effect. Coaches & Officials shall wear their USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location while on deck at the meet.

Scoring: 1-8 place over all in individual & relay events and team scores

Concession: Available All Sessions

Identification: Coaches and Officials shall wear their 2018 USA Swimming registration card in a conspicuous location while on

deck during a swim meet.or be able to present it via Deck Pass when asked.

Supervision: Each swimmer participating in a Florida Swimming sanctioned meet must be supervised during warm-up and competition by a current Coach member of USA Swimming. An unattached athlete or an athlete not escorted

competition by a current Coach member of USA Swimming. An unattached athlete or an athlete not escorted by a Coach member must check in with the Meet Referee upon arrival at the meet. Such athletes must find a substitute Coach who will supervise him/her during warm-up and competition and must submit the enclosed

Alternate Coaches Form (signed) to the Meet Referee.

Camera Zone: Per Florida Swimming Rule 223.12, Meet management shall designate and inform the public of "Camera Zone"

at each swim meet where both still photography and video photography of a race or a race competitor in a race may be taken. Under NO circumstances will Camera Zones include the area immediately behind the starting blocks at either end of the racing course while they are in use for "race starting purposes" during competition and warm-ups, locker rooms, restrooms, or any other dressing area. Any individual failing to abide by this rule

could be subject to the Florida Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Rule 239.2

Meet Committee: A committee consisting of the Meet Manager, Meet Referee, two volunteer coaches from visiting teams and one

senior athlete, will be formed prior to the meet, and shall be wholly responsible for making decisions regarding delaying, postponing or canceling the meet or any portion of the meet in the event of inclement weather or other threatening conditions, or any situation requiring a decision of the Committee regarding the meet. The

committee will meet as needed.
