#### PRESIDENT'S REMARKS

#### Hi All.

I have just returned from today's VOM Water District meeting where we were given an update on the backflows. 101 Chantarelle homeowners have signed contracts with VOM to do the backflow installation. This number represents 83% of our community. The total for Creekside, Temelec and Chantarelle represents approximately 95% of the total homeowners in our three communities (771). The VOM will work from north to south, beginning with Temelec and ending with Chantarelle. The Temelec segment of the project is

slated to begin this month. We are sure we have made the right decision to purchase the faux boulder backflow covers. The dimensions were given to VOM a few weeks ago to insure a nice finished look. Decisions regarding boulder color choices will be made in the future, as we have plenty of time before the installations begin. If you missed the September HOA meeting, during which we displayed boulder samples, you can view the samples in front of my home at 104 S Temelec. New water meters will be installed as well as an expansion tank on the backflow when installed. VOM will contact USA Utility Alerts when the construction of our backflows is to take place. A standard lock will also be provided for security and inspections.

#### **Redwood Trees**

The HOA has received a very detailed report from an independent arborist regarding the redwood trees in back of the clubhouse. I read the letter in its entirety at the September Board meeting, and I have given copies to two homeowners who voiced specific concerns. The Board will review the findings and go from there.

#### **Entry Signs**

The HOA Board also voted to accept a bid on entry signs from Well Design, a company in Napa. There will be three new signs (raised above the existing walls) with 12-inch aluminum letters, two at the entrance on Arnold Drive and one at the rear entrance on the corner of Watmaugh and Hermosa Parkway.
