Cool Cruisers' Day at Cofer Museum & Tucker Cruise-in

We were *AMAZED* at the response for both the Museum Tour and the Main Street Cruisein! We had over 40 members show up for each on Saturday, August 10. They were not disappointed in either event!

Our Club members were treated to a tour of the private collection of the Cofer family, known as *"Stable of Thoroughbreds,"* with an opening talk by **Chip Cofer**, son of Gene Cofer, who amassed the collection. We then heard more detailed insight on many of the cars by curator **Cecil McCall.** The eclectic collection is one of the finest in the Southeast and includes many rare cars from the early 1900's.

One of the most enjoyable features of the museum is that the cars are NOT roped off, so guests can see them up close. An interesting fact, Cecil has the task of driving each of the cars at least 50 miles every three to four months. Chip makes sure that the route for the cars included as many right turns as possible for safety.

Our second part of our day was as the "Featured Club" at the **Tucker Main Street Cruise-in.** Twenty of our cars got to park down the middle of Main. We had the largest participation of ANY featured club at the event, and some members had to park with the "regular" show cars.

We were well represented in the show awards too, with four members taking home "Sweet 16" plaques. The Georgia Cool Cruisers received recognition for being a sponsor for the event and got to select a show car for an award.
