A little history. . . Struggling with lowered attendance, the Nebraska State Fair was thought by some to be threatened with termination in the early years of the new millennium. In 2008 the Nebraska state lawmakers decided (LB1116), with the help of the University of Nebraska, which wanted the land cleared for a new [Nebraska Innovation Campus](#), to move the fair to Grand Island. Several citizens filed a legal challenge to the law, contending that it "created a special benefit" for some of the groups and people involved in the plan.^[3] However, in May 2010 the Nebraska Supreme Court rejected those arguments and upheld an earlier dismissal of the lawsuit.^{[4][5]} The state allocated \$42 million to construct new facilities in Grand Island, building adjacent to the city's existing county fairgrounds, arena, and horse track at Fonner Park and the Heartland Event Center.
