- a. Archipelago: chain of islands
- b. 4 main islands, over 3,000 smaller islands
- c. Located in the Ring of Fire (prone to earthquakes, tsunamis and volcanoes)
- d. 11% of land can be farmed
- e. Ethnocentric and Isolated
- f. Shintoism: "way of the gods"
- g. Worshipped the *kami* or Divinities.
- h. Worshipped nature and ancestors

II. Rise of Japan

- i Society based on clans
- ii Yamato Clan 300-700
- iii Seventh century Yamato Prince Shotoku wrote the Taika Reforms which modified Japanese government
- iv Japan took Chinese gov't, writing, Confucianism and Buddhism

III. Classical Japan

- a. Rise of Buddhism during the Nara period in 710
- b. Heian period 794-1185
- c. Golden Age improved culture
- d. Tale of the Genji Written by Lady Murasaki
- e. Gave noble women status
- f. Birth of Samurai (those who serve)
- g. Zen Buddhism- enlightenment achieved suddenly or through self-discipline

IV Kamakura Shogunate

- 1. 1185 powerful noble creates empire
- 2. Shogun has real power (general of the military)
- 3. This is the birth of feudalism in Japan 1192
- 4. Kamakura fell in 1333 but laid foundation for feudal Japan
