IRS TAX Form 1095 B

Who will send me the Form 1095 B?	Health insurance carriers are responsible for sending out the 1095 B to employees enrolled on our health insurance in 2015. The form will also list family members that were enrolled in 2015.
Why am I receiving it?	As of 2014, Health Care Reform required most U.S. citizens to carry health insurance either through their employer or on an individual plan. Tax form 1095 B is your proof of coverage and contains information about your health insurance plan. It shows your covered family members along with the months of the year each person was covered. New Health Care Reform legislation requires health insurance carriers to send tax form 1095 B to the IRS as notification that you were covered on health insurance. The law also requires the carrier to provide you with a copy of what was sent to the IRS.
What do I need to do with it?	The information provided to you by the health insurance carriers is for information purposes only. You do not need to submit the form with your tax filings. You should retain a copy for your records as proof that you were enrolled on coverage for the listed months.
