Show Me Strong Recovery Plan Citizen Guidelines

By the order of Governor Mike Parson, the Director of the Department of Health and Senior Services has issued the Economic Reopening Health Order effective Monday, May 4, 2020. The entire Health Order, can be found on our website.

The Show Me Strong Recovery Plan requires citizens to maintain six feet (6') of social distancing space in most cases. There are certain situations that require additional procedures to protect businesses, communities, and citizens.

- Citizens who feel sick should stay home!
- Continue to practice good hygiene, including:
 - ✓ Washing hands with soap and water, or using hand sanitizer, especially after touching frequently used items or surfaces;
 - ✓ Avoiding touching your face;
 - ✓ Sneezing or coughing into a tissue, or the inside of your elbow; and
 - ✓ Disinfecting frequently used items and surfaces as much as possible.
- Avoid socializing in groups that do not readily allow for appropriate physical distancing (receptions, concerts, trade shows, etc.).

Absentee Voting for June 2 Election

Voters have until 5:00pm on May 20th to request an absentee ballot from the Warren County Clerk's office, by mail, for the June 2nd Municipal Election. If you wish to receive an absentee ballot, please print and complete the Request for Absentee Ballot form found at <https://warrencountymoclerk.com/absentee-voter-information/> and submit to the Warren County Clerk via email, fax, or US Mail by the deadline. If you are concerned about appearing in person to vote on June 2nd, mark the second reason; *"Incapacity or confinement due to illness or physical disability, including caring for a person who is incapacitated or confined due to illness or disability"*. Please call (636) 456-3331 if you have any questions or require assistance with the form. The Village of Innsbrook encourages all of its residents to vote via absentee ballot in order to eliminate crowds on election day. Our main concern is the health and safety of our residents and the election judges that are required to operate the polls. When voting in person, please be mindful of social distancing guidelines and other measures to protect all individuals while visiting Village Hall on June 2nd.

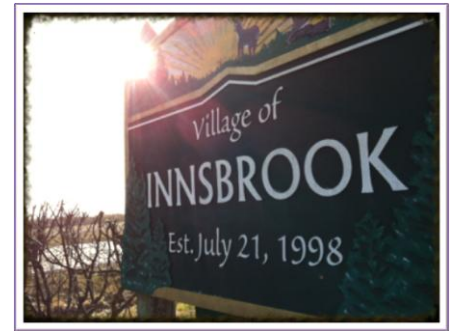
Village Hall To Remain Closed
