WARREN COUNTY (PEQUEST RIVER) MUNICIPAL UTILITIES AUTHORITY

MINUTES April 18, 2023

Chairperson Napolitani called the regular meeting of the Warren County (Pequest River) Municipal Utilities Authority to order at 7:00 p.m. The meeting was held at the Authority's Administration building located at 199 Foul Rift Road, Belvidere, New Jersey.

Roll Call:

Also, in attendance: Kim Francisco, Authority CFO; Brian Tipton, Esq., Authority Legal Counsel, Ronald B. Madison, P.E., Authority Engineer; John Inscho, Executive Director; and Susan Wright, Administrative Assistant.

Chairwoman Napolitani led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance and then read the Introductory Statement.

MINUTES

Mr. Roth moved, and Mr. Accetturo seconded to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2023 regular meeting, as presented. All in favor, motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE

Mr. Norton recapped the correspondence listed below:

- 1. Notice from Tim Matthews to the White Township Planning Board for properties identified as Block 16, Lot 44 and Block 16, Lot 12, located at 648 & 650 Brass Castle Road, Township of White, County of Warren for a minor subdivision to reduce Lot 44 from 70.76 acres to 6 acres and increase Lot 12 from 36.92 acres to 101.68 acres.
- 2. Town of Belvidere Resolution No. R2023x25, designating Block 38, Lots 2, 3, 4 & 5; Block 47, Lot 10; Block 48, Lot 7; and portions of Sixth Street, Seventh Street, Hardwick Street, Knowlton Street and Independence Street Right-of-Way as a non-condemnation redevelopment area.

- 3. March 2023 Memorandum from Jeff S. Ignatowitz, PERS Secretary to all Certifying Officers, Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) regarding their Notice of Election.
- 4. Notice from Lavery, Selvaggi, Abromitis & Cohen, Attorneys for Applicant, Cheema Oil Corp. to the White Township Zoning Board of Adjustments for the properties known as Block, 39, Lots 6 & 6.01, located at 274 Route 46, Township of White, County of Warren seeking to extend and amend the previously approved preliminary and final site plan approval, use and bulk variance relief on March 15, 2018.

ENGINEER'S REPORT

Mr. Madison summarized his report which was included in the agenda packets, as well as his supplemental report in connection with capital improvements, which was provided to the Commissioners.

A walk-through of the Belvidere Plant was scheduled on Friday, April 14, 2023 with the Engineers, Operators, Mr. Inscho and Chairwoman Napolitani, wherein efficiency and improvement of the plant was discussed. Colliers will be preparing the first draft of a capital plan within the next couple of months.

There were discussions regarding the technological improvements necessary at the Belvidere plant and also, joining the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative. Mr. Madison advised that his office will provide the Board with information regarding the same.

Mr. Roth inquired about cybersecurity and that Mr. Madison had previously advised about recommendations. Mr. Madison advised that a request can be made to the Department of Homeland Security and they will provide a field audit with recommendations.

There was a discussion regarding the pump station/pipeline in White Township and having the Engineer speak on behalf of the Authority at future meetings with the Township, if this issue is not resolved.

CFO'S REPORT

Auditors finished the field work and they are working on the final report.

Mr. Francisco summarized the monthly financial report.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Mr. Tipton had nothing to report.

FINANCE

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #23-13 (Certificate No. 440: \$117,736.58) be approved to pay all bills from the Operating Fund, as presented. Mr. Roth seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

Mr. Accetturo moved that Resolution #23-14 (Certificate No. 446: \$13,196.19) be approved to pay all bills from the Capital Improvements Fund as presented. Mr. Norton seconded. All in favor, motion passed.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Mr. Inscho advised that American Water tied into the Oxford sewer without notifying the Authority. After looking into this issue documentation and plans were found dating back to 2017 and 2018, wherein the cost of the hook-up was \$6,642.00, which is the residential hook-up fee. According to the documentation, they were to pay not only the hook-up fee, but also an application fee of \$400.00, which he is unsure whether that fee was paid. In addition, the Authority was to be notified so that it could be inspected. According to the Engineer who provided the plan, David Clark of CP Engineers, it is one laboratory sink (1 EDU) that is connected. Not sure whether in the future there will be more connections. Mr. Norton will look into what information Oxford may have regarding this issue and Mr. Inscho will contact Mr. Clark to request further information/documentation.

Oxford Plant: All three pump stations were vacuumed and cleaned out by Spectraserv.

Belvidere: Mechanical Screen is not working properly. The manufacturer will be sending someone out to take a closer look at it.

Paul Stamm from OSHA came out once again to perform his repeat inspection. We are down to four (4) items that need to be completed. He was very impressed with the conditions of the buildings. Our two new Operators have done a great job of improving the buildings.

Stateline Tree did a great job removing several trees and grinding some of the stumps on the Belvidere property.

Mr. Inscho advised the Board that for the past several weeks, Ms. Wright has been cleaning out and organizing the administration building.

AUTHORITY CHAIRWOMAN

Chairwoman Napolitani brought up an issue that when our facilities are closed, for holidays or weekends, no employee should be allowed on the property to use the facility for their own personal use. This is more for insurance and liability purposes. She inquired how this should be addressed, whether it be in a memorandum or incorporated it into the personnel policy. The Board agreed to determine whether it will be necessary after the Executive Session.

WCMUA minutes 3 April 18, 2023

Chairwoman Napolitani requested that for the Authority's May 16, 2023 regular meeting, a tour of the Belvidere Plant be scheduled at 6:00 p.m. and then the meeting be held immediately thereafter. The Board agreed to the same.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

There was no unfinished business.

NEW BUSINESS

There was no new business.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

At approximately 8:02 p.m., Mr. Roth moved, and Mr. Godfrey seconded to adopt Resolution #23-15, to enter into an executive session to discuss personnel matters. All in favor, motion passed. Mr. Francisco, Mr. Madison and Ms. Wright, were excused during said executive session.

At 8:35 p.m., Mr. Accetturo moved, and Mr. Norton seconded to return to open session. All in favor, motion passed.

Mr. Tipton advised that the Board has authorized him to write a letter to Operator Mike Codis advising him that he is being suspended with pay effective immediately. Mr. Inscho and Mr. Tipton will be contacting Mr. Codis after the meeting to advise him of the same.

Chairwoman Napolitani also wanted to discuss with the Board that the two new Operators have once again requested a discussion regarding their health insurance upon retirement. There was a brief discussion among the Board, no official decision was made.

As there was no more business to come before the Authority, Mr. Godfrey moved for the meeting to be adjourned. The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
