

# from your Vice President

Hello from Wisconsin,

I started a new job with St. Croix Hospice on August 14th, 2023 to be a full-time Hospice Nurse. I trained with the three different RN Case Managers over a 5 week period at which time, I decided that I was ready to be on my own as a Hospice Visit Nurse.

I go to nursing homes, assisted living facilities and patient's homes to do hospice visits. This position involves taking and recording patient vitals, doing head to toe assessments, ordering any medications that may be needed and ordering supplies for patients such as adult briefs, wet wipes, etc. I contact our hospice doctor for orders if a patient needs any labs such as UA, or if a patient appears to have an infection and is in need of an antibiotic or needs a refill for a controlled substance such as Tramadol, Lorazepam, or Morphine.

As a hospice visit nurse I can order medications in an electronic ordering system called E3Pro and then let the hospice doctor know by text message that an e-script is ready for his signature. The doctor can then go into E3Pro and sign the scripts electronically. I also do all of my charting electronically on my employer provided cell phone utilizing the talk to text feature that is built into the charting system called PointCare.

LPN/LVN hospice nurses are also permitted to do PRN and On-Call visits for falls that don't include a significant injury as well change of condition not including deaths. Those visits include taking vital signs, head to toe assessments, charting, patient safety analysis, a client occurrence, contacting both the hospice doctor and family with updates; and notifying the Supervisor and RN Case Manager along with any other staff that may interact with the patient that is being seen.

I love this job that I am now doing because I am able to spend 1:1 time with my patients and give them the love and special time that they deserve!

Hi, my name is Debbie Blahnik, treasurer for WALPN.

I have had the privilege to be certified to carry epinephrine, via an epi pen, and administer in an allergic reaction. I am happy to tell you that any adult in Wisconsin can get certified, thanks to Angel and George Mueller from Mishicot, Wisconsin.

This is Angel and George's mission:
DO IT FOR DILLON!!! Dillon Mueller Memorial Fund

Dillon was an 18-year-old, fun-loving, energetic, passionate young man who got stung by a bee and died of a fatal allergic reaction. We later found out that you never know when you can acquire an allergy. We don't know if Dillon had been stung before or if this was his first time. Access to epinephrine may have saved his life. However, epinephrine is only available by prescription and since Dillon had not been diagnosed with an allergy, he did not have epinephrine available. If you can acquire an allergy at any point in life, how do you get a prescription for life-saving medicine?

#### CMS MINIMUM STAFFING IN LTC

NALPN has received much information about the CMS Minimum staffing standards in LTC facilities. Therefore, the NALPN Board of Directors will be gathering information on this matter, and responding to the CMS with our POSITION on what they are recommending.

You might have heard that the CMS has NOT included LPNs in staffing minimums for LTC, which is a slap in the face to most LPNs/LVNs. More than 75% of nurses in LTC are LPNs/LVNs, and CMS has not included them in their report. It is a sad thing that people who don't know what is really being done in LTC, are making recommendations for staffing.

WALPN will keep you posted on what we find out, and if important, we will do an E-Blast to keep you informed.


