Don Langston was second in the Angler division fishing the edge of weed beds on Lake Cortez with a Texas rigged green pumpkin Senko (top right). Second place Co-Angler was Tim Brown fishing a wacky rigged worm (lower right) on shady side of Lake Coronado docks
