

New Vienna City Council Meeting  
October 2,2018

Mayor Pat Hermsen opened the special meeting at 5:30pm. Present were council members: Roger Langel, Jim Naber, T.J. Kloser, Kathy Engelken, Absent: Mike Leuchs

Kloser made the motion to approve the agenda for October 2,2018 seconded by Naber.

Naber made the motion to approve the consent agenda, second by Engelken.

The Veterans Memorial Committee was present to give an update on the project. Bob McCabe and Fred Westhoff informed the council that Security cameras will be installed and they are getting quotes on this now. The engraving is being done on the other larger stones, and the dedication will be November 11<sup>th</sup> if all goes well.

The Mayor informed the council that Mike Neuhaus, Angie Oberbroeckling, Roger Langel and himself had met with Josh Demmer the architect to go over the final plans. The Council discussed the process for the building and timeline and donations and fund raising. There will be a public information table at the Fire Dept. Breakfast on November 18, 2018.

Resolution #14-2018 APPROVING THE BROWNFIELD COALITION was approved on a motion from Langel, second by Naber. Ayes-all.

Mike Neuhaus presented the water and sewer report and informed the council that we had pumped 596,595 gallons normal gallons pumped per day is around 18,000. The sewer main has been repaired behind NV Ag also and has been working well with all this rain. Joe Fangman did not want our solution to the issue he presented to the council, so the City will not pursue this work.

The council reviewed the Annual Financial Report that the clerk had finished and was ready to be published.

Building permit for TJ Kloser for a driveway addition and Mark Rolfes for new metal siding was approved on a motion from Langel, second by Naber. Ayes- Naber, Engelken, Langel, Abstain-Kloser as it was his permit to approve.

The council discussed special event pay for the Police dept. The Mayor will talk to the police chief regarding this as the city did not authorize the pay increase. The Mayor went over the information and cost involved to add another part time officer to the department.

Trick or Treat date was set for October 31,2018 from 5:30 to 7:00pm.
