IV.Treasurer's Report

- The current balance in the District 14 fund is \$2,281.22 Α.
 - 1. That is a \$100 decrease from this time last year
- B. \$1,164 was deposited from the District 14 All-Star game
 - 1. \$1,250 were the expenses for the All-Star game

V.All-Star Game

- Tina Magill asks that coaches do a better job of getting the word out about the tshirts for the All-Star game.
 - 1. An online store can be set up again, but coaches need to let the parents know how to get to the store.
 - 2. If parents want to purchase a shirt and they missed the deadline to get it at the game, Tina can ask that the online store allow parents to purchase a shirt online. The parents would have to pay shipping and handling so that the shirt can be sent to their home.

VI.District Trustee

- Coaches need to become a member of the state association (OHSVCA) if you want your players to have a chance to be nominated for state awards or the state All-Star game for your senior players
 - 1. The link to that website is: http://www.ohsvca.org/index.php/events/clinic
 - Click on the "Registration" button and insert your information
- a. You will be able to pick membership only at the end of the registration process b.
 - 1. The cost to be a member is \$25. A late fee if paid between October 1st-October 31st is \$125. If the membership is paid after November 1st the cost is \$225.
 - 2. You must be a member in order to poll vote as well.
- You must poll vote in order to nominate your players for All-Ohio awards. a.

- 1. You must poll vote at least 5 out of the 6 weeks to be eligible to nominate your players for All-Ohio awards.
- 3. You also must put game stats on MaxPreps in order to nominate your players for All-Ohio.
- a. OHSVCA has a list of what stats you need to keep.
 - 1. There are also definitions available for each stat.
- b. IStatVball is a program that will export stats straight to MaxPrep
 - Our top senior player in each division in District 14 will represent our district in the Ohio All-Star game, so it is very important to be a member of the OHSVCA
- B. OHSVCA had a camp at Tiffin with six DII and DIII college coaches
 - 1. 85 players could attend, but they didn't have that many players attend
 - 2. This may or may not be available next year
- a. They OHSVCA will discuss changes that need to be made to make it more successful

VIII.Guest Speaker-Mark Rose

- A. Online rules meeting needs to be completed by August 15th through your myohsaa account
 - 1. New coaches need to make sure to register for a myohsaa account
- B. You have the opportunity to evaluate up to 50 officials during the season
 - 1. You can only evaluate each referee one time, but if you see them multiple times during the season, you can change your evaluation as many times as you need.
 - 2. You AD has the link, and they need to invite you so you can do that evaluations.
 - 3. If you are unable to read a referee's name or number in your scorebook, you can contact Mark Rose at rosem@claylocalschools.org or your AD may be able to help with this information.
 - 4. Once the regular season is over, your AD can request 15 officials for the tournament, so make sure to communicate with your AD about which officials you prefer.
- C. Before tournament draw takes place, make sure to submit your team bio with your overall record, record by division, important wins, etc.
 - 1. You should get an email with a reminder of when to submit this information.
- a. There is a \$50 fine if not submitted on time.
- b. You will have to vote once team bios are submitted, and there is a \$50 if you do not vote.
 - 1. Please make sure you vote professionally

- D. Any concerns with sites, officials, official's calls, etc. please discuss this with our District Trustee Laura Smith
- E. SEDAB will be piloting a new voting for boys and girls basketball where coaches won't vote in pods or groups of teams in your division, but coaches will vote for all teams in your division in your district.
 - #1 overall pick would get to decide where they want to be placed on the brackets and all other teams would be placed according to place.
 - 2. If you have an opinion about voting like this, pass it on to our coaches association or send opinion to Mark Rose
 - 3. The reason this idea hasn't passed in the past is because of the extra travel it causes to many teams
- F. Rule Changes
 - 1. Rosters are now due during captains meeting.
- a. Point/side out is the penalty if not submitted on time.
- b. If varsity coaches decide to have your captain's meeting during the JV, to roster must be submitted at the start of the warmups for the varsity game.
 - 1. Net height for junior high is now the same height as the net height for the high school.
 - 2. Libero uniform just has to be contrasting this year.
- a. Questions about whether or not your uniforms are contrasting, you can contact Mark Rose or Emily Gates.
 - 1. Net system supports need to be out of play, especially for the systems that come down from the ceiling.
 - 2. Uniforms are not to be changed on the bench.
- a. Penalty is a yellow card for the coach.
 - 1. Please read "This Week in Volleyball" sent by Emily Gates weekly.
- a. Has information about rule changes, deadlines, etc.
- b. She is part of OHSAA
 - 1. Insulin pumps may need a waiver from state in order for a player to be allowed to play with it.
 - 2. Warmup for tournament play is 2-6-6-3-3
- a. You are not supposed to be on the court if it isn't your team's court time, but most courts are big enough to use the out of bounds where teams are not hitting in your direction.
 - 1. Plastic plugs to replace earrings or nose piercings are allowed as long as they are flush with the skin and don't stick out.
