n Conclave • Rules of S.J. Propounded by St. Ignatius

St. Ignatius of Loyola was the founder and first General of the Society of Jesus also known as the Jesuits.

He was born in Spain in 1491 and died in Rome on July 31, 1556. He was the youngest of eleven children.

Besides writing the rules of conduct and instructions, such as the famed Letter of Obedience in 1553, St. Ignatius spent several years of thought and experimentation in determining the constitutions for his Order.

In this painting he is shown teaching the rules of his Order to his first followers.
