A Note from Rick: Markets were softer this week at TLA. Slaughter cows were \$3-\$5 lower this week compared to last. It's that time of year when this market gets a lot of pressure on the supply side. The numbers of cattle coming to the market are up across the country. This happens every year and usually lasts til around Thanksgiving. I look for prices to continue to struggle through this period. Calf prices were softer this week, as well. Again, we had a big run of calves on Tuesday and that puts extra pressure on prices. The hay market was a little stronger again this week. There was very little change in dairy cattle and feeder markets, which has been the case for some time now. We'll get a good test on both these markets over the next 2 weeks with our Special Springer sale on the 14th and the Special Feeder sale on the 19th. We held our 1st annual TLA Classic Halter Show for all breeds of draft horses last Saturday and it went off really well. We had around 65 horses and are very excited about the future of this event. We're looking forward to the Friesian Fall Classic this weekend and hope to see you here at TLA!!
