REV. GORDON H. LIGHT 1924 - 1996

Rev. Gordon H. Light, 71, pastor of Immaraud Lutheran Church, Sebenseing, from 1956-1964, ded at 10:50 p.m. Saturday, March 16, in Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak, billowing a long ilmess.

He was born in Windsor, Ont., on Dec. 22, 1924, the son of Horace and Sarah (Dickson) Light. He was graduated from Case Technical High School in Detroit and was employed as a draftsman for Ford Motor Company, when the vicer of Epipheny Lutheran Church, Detroit, inwhed him to consider the ministry as his career. He entered Concordia College in 1946, spent his vicerage year at Outer Drive Faith Lutheren Church, Detroit, and was graduated from Concordia Saminery at Springhett, L. in 1962.

On July 12, 1962, he and Elizabeth

Abrecht were memed, and on Aug. 3, 1962, he was ordeined into the ministry. He first cell took him to a dual ministry at St. John Church of Pleasant Plains, L. and Emmanuel Church, Fermingdale, IL. in 1964 he accepted a cell to another dual ministry, as he became the first resident pastor of St. Johns Lutheran Church, Houghton Lake, and also served Mt. Hope Church, Graying.

Four years later, in 1968, he accepted the call of immenual Church of Sebawaing. where he remained until 1964, when he began a nine-year ministry at St. Paul Church,

Trenton.

For his next cell, in October, 1973, he began serving Orces of Christ Lutheran Church, Bloomfeld Hills, where he remained for 21 1/2 years, retiring on Dec. 31, 1993, having completed more than 42 years in church service.

Since his retirement he continued to serve as pastor emeritus at Lutheran Church

of the Padeamer, Birmingham.

At his retirement, he had completed 13 years as a member of the Michigan District LCAMS Board of Directors, holding all four vice-president offices, from fourth to first, and also worked on many committees in those offices before and after retirement.

Surviving, beside his wife Elizabeth are four sone, David, Robert, Thomas and Gordon Light, 10 grandchildren, and one sister, Jeanne Pataton of Port Richey, FL.

The funeral service will take place at 10 a.m. Wednesday, March 20, in Church of the Redeemer, Birmingham, with interment in Glen Eden Cemelary.
