



We look forward to seeing your child's creativity and engineering skills displayed for the enjoyment of the students at our LEGO BrickFest on March 16, 2018. Please read the following instructions.

A Reminder about size limits: Please make sure that the creation is on a sturdy base no larger than 15"x15".

Artist Nameplate Card: Please complete this "sign" for the creation and bring it to drop-off. The sign template can be found on the PTA website: www.lincroftpta.org

Delivering your LEGO creation to Lincroft School (The event begins at 9am on March 16th):

- Drop off the LEGO creation:
 - **Friday, March 16th, from 8:00am-8:45am**
PARK AT LITTLE LEAGUE FIELDS AND BRING TO LEOPARD'S DEN DOOR
- Recommendations/Suggestions:
 - Do not have your child transport their creation on the bus as it will likely be damaged.
 - Arrange a carpool with other participants.
 - If your child has built a complex creation, take the major parts of the creation apart and re-assemble it in the Leopard's Den.
 - Transport the creation in a box and label the box with the child's name and teacher.
 - **Children cannot be dropped off at school early or left in the Leopard's Den if it is prior to 8:45.**

Picking up your LEGO creation from Lincroft School:

- Pick up the LEGO creation:
 - **Friday March 16th between 2:30pm and 3:30pm**
PARK AT LITTLE LEAGUE FIELDS AND COME TO THE LEOPARD'S DEN DOOR
- Important: Creations that are voted as best in a grade or category will be displayed in the front hall display case or in the office. When the votes are counted and winners determined, we will contact the parents of the winners by 2:00pm so they need not pick up the creation.
- Creations not picked up on Friday must be picked up on Monday or they will be sent home with your child.
- The winning creations will remain at school for a week or two. A pick-up date and time will be e-mailed to all creation winners.
