In 1999, he began serving on the Springdale School Board. He served as president of the board from 2005 to 2007. In November of 2008, he was elected mayor of Springdale. He also serves as vice-chairman of the Regional Mobility Authority

and is a member of the Executive Committee of the Arkansas Municipal League.
