#### Tri-County Black Nurse Association Post Office Box 20816 Charleston, South Carolina 29413 Scholarship Requirements

- 1. Scholarship awardee must apply for membership in Tri-County Black Nurses Association (TCBNA) and the National Black Nurses Association for at least one year.
- 2. Applicants must prove enrollment in an accredited BSN or ADN nursing program in the state of South Carolina, and he/she must be in good academic standing at the time of application.
- 3. Applicants must have at least one full year remaining in their respective nursing program.

Note - Applicant enrolled in an accelerated nursing program must have at least one remaining semester.

- 4. Applications must include the following: educational and work experiences, extracurricular activities, and community service. Extracurricular and community service may include but is not limited to involvement in local nursing chapter, community or school projects, other organizational efforts, and/or state-level student nursing activity.
- 5. Applicants **MUST** attach and submit a one-page essay addressing **each of the following**. Essay must be a minimum of 750 words, double-spaced, and 12-font.
  - i) Explain your nursing goals
  - ii) Explain why you are the best candidate for this scholarship
  - iii) Explain, as a nurse, how you plan to affect the health and wellness of African Americans and/or underserved populations/communities.
- 6. Applicants must submit an official transcript and two (2) letters of recommendation on official stationary with appropriate letterhead and contact phone number. Letters of recommendation from employers, instructors, service organizations, or community leaders are acceptable.
- 7. Scholarship awardee will spend at least four hours volunteering in TCBNA related community activities (i.e. community health fairs, the Annual Kwanza Celebration, the Annual Bubbling Brown Sugar Diabetes initiatives, and The Annual Delma Woods & Aleta McLeod-Bryant Health and Wellness Fair).

 Scholarship awardee will attend (along with one guest) the Tri-County Black Nurses Association Annual Scholarship Luncheon on Saturday, May 6, 2017 from 11:00am-2:00pm at Arthur Christopher Community Center, 265 Fishburne Street, Charleston SC. The cost for additional guests is \$30.00 per person.
