In 2008 after a routine eye exam, he was diagnosed with Anaplastic Oligodendroglioma. He underwent emergency surgery removing 95% of a baseball size tumor. He has gone through multiple chemotherapy and radiation treatments over the years and continues clinical trials seeking any hope of a cure. Vince has hit a point in his disease where conventional medicine is no longer effective, but he is keeping a positive outlook and hopes one day to feel well enough to be out walking his dogs.
