2017 Grand Marshal Frankie Hancock

Longtime Holden resident and friend to everyone, Frankie Hancock was chosen to be the 2017 Grand Marshal of the Holden Street Fair and Parade.

Frankie was born and raised near Medford, attending grade school in the historic Pleasant View one-room schoolhouse, which was just a 'walk across the pasture' from her home.

Her mother passed away when Frankie was just six years old. Her father went on to raise Frankie and her five sisters on his

own, never remarrying.

She has said her dad taught them all the value of hard work, a trait that would serve Frankie well all of her life.

Continuing her education after grade school, she rode Reno Coskey's homemade

bus to Holden High School where she graduated as salutatorian of her class. Her aspirations after high school didn't include college; instead, all she ever wanted to be was a wife and mother.

Frankie married Don Hancock in 1941, and the couple, over the years, were blessed with seven children. Don was an army medic for nearly three years in the European Theater of Operations.

He was discharged in November, 1945 and returned to school at Missouri Valley College in Marshall, graduating in 1949. He was a Kroger store manager for several years, before and after his military service.

Don worked for Texas Refinery Corp., Protective Coatings Division, where he earned trips to exotic places around the world

for himself and Frankie.

The Hancocks owned a real estate business which, at one time, consisted of more than 80 rental properties. Frankie, with her ever-present work ethic, did her part by doing much of the maintenance on the properties.

Frankie is a lifelong member of Medford Methodist Church, and has taken care of the church (cleaning it), and the church grounds, mowing, weed eating, etc. for most of her life.

She relished her 'career' as a stay-athome mom until 1960, when she was called to work for Drs. Don, Cunningham and Moreland at Holden Hospital and Clinic. Thus began her new career, that of caring for her friends, neighbors and others in the community. When the clinic closed in 1965, she worked for a time at a care center in Warrensburg until Dr. James Holmberg asked her to come to work for him. She also worked there with Dr. Edward Schwab and Dr. Arthur Corpolongo.

She worked in that office for 14 years, until Dr. Holmberg retired and Drs. Schwab and Corpolongo went to military service. She also worked for Dr. Kelly Rawlins for several years, then in 1981 she went to work for Dr. Thomas Wescott, until his death in 2002.

Her nursing career spanned many years and she has cared for many patients/families in this area for decades. Everyone remembers Nurse Frankie and her kind, caring ways.

Frankie passed on the value of hard work, loyalty, dedication and kindness to all of her children. Her offspring have blessed her with many grandchildren, many more great-grandchildren, and even a few great-great-grandchildren. "Be fruitful and multiply" is a scripture Frankie took to heart!

Her boys were active in Boy Scouts, some attaining the rank of Eagle Scout. Her eldest son, James, graduated from Paola, KS. high school; he died in 1989 from astrocytoma of the brain. Judy, David, Dennis, Charles, Jon and Bill are all graduates of Holden High School. Bill also graduated summa cum laude from UCM. All of the other boys are self-employed in lucrative businesses.

For many years, Frankie has cleaned houses, in addition to her regular jobs. She also cared for her niece Ruth Gardner after she suffered a stroke. Frankie would go stay with Ruth once a week, every week, and do housecleaning and laundry, and raise Ruth's spirits. Frankie kept visiting Ruth and her family faithfully until Ruth moved away.

Currently, Frankie is working at the Holden Image as proofreader, a position she's held since Rusty Hartwell asked her to come and work for the paper in 2002. She's been brightening up the office of the Image ever since.

She's a very caring, cheerful mentor to

her younger co-workers and holds a special place in their hearts. And though she doesn't clean houses anymore, she still faithfully cleans the Image office. Now in her 15th year at the Image, she says she plans to stay on as long as John Roberts tolerates her!

Frankie is proud of the fact that she has never applied for a job, but instead has been asked if she would come to work for that particular office.

Over the years Frankie has received well-deserved accolades for quietly going around town, doing what needs to be done, always behind the scenes. She is a humble, prayerful, loyal friend to all she meets. Although she had some health problems last year, she didn't let it keep her from her duties for very long.

In her 90-plus years, she has been honored for her good works. In 1990, she was honored as Woman of the Year by local sorority Preceptor Zeta Omega. In 1992, she was one of Missouri's Outstanding Older Workers. In February of 2000, she and Dr. Wescott were honored by the Holden Chamber of Commerce and Holden Image for their years of service to the community, with a reception at the Hallar Building.

The awards and honors just keep coming for Frankie, as in 2015 she won Outstanding Older Worker of Missouri for Region 6. For that impressive award she was given a reception at the Redneck Country Club, hosted by the Holden Image. She was honored by the State of Missouri, Johnson County commissioners, and the City of Holden.

As the winner of that prestigious award, she and one of her sons were invited to Jefferson City for a gala banquet, tours of the Capital, and an awards ceremony. Her co-worker and employer also were privileged to attend to honor Frankie. All of her sons were invited to the awards banquet and she was so humbled and thrilled by the honor and so proud her sons and their wives could be there to share in her special moment.

Frankie truly epitomizes what it means to be a caring, thoughtful, selfless Christian woman, and she has left her mark on many folks in her 93 years as a member of this community.




