GENERAL MEETING – November 8th

Mack Canada Inc. treated us to a very nice relaxing and informative evening. Mack as usual took full advantage of the platform the ATSSA offers by orchestrating a good turn out to update their staff and dealer personnel and end-users/operators, as well as ATSSA members.



Once again Steven DeSousa-Service Director for Canada-quarterbacked proceedings with his usual flair. Curtis Dorwart, Refuse Product Manager for Mack Trucks Inc., delivered most effectively, a review of the evolution of their integrated powertrain with the introduction of the 2017 Mack[®] MP[®] series engines which has realized significant improvements in fuel efficiency, power and productivity, while reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Curtis explained the upgrades and enhancements which includes: a common-rail fuel system that injects fuel more precisely; a wave piston design that raises compression ratio and enables more complete combustion, and a two speed coolant pump. These features help increase MP7 (11-L) fuel efficiency by up to 5.1% and MP8 (13-L) by up to 5%. Other improvements more directly targets reducing maintenance costs such as an integrated aftertreatment dosing module. Mack will also offer the 2017 MP8 with turbo compounding-which converts waste exhaust energy into mechanical energy-adding 50 HP.

These updated 2017 MP engines complement Mack's recently launched Mack mDRIVE HD 13 and 14speed automated manual transmissions. The 16-L MP10 remains unchanged at 605 HP & 2,060 lbs.ft torque.

All of the above product currently available. Curtis also briefly reviewed their Mack Predictive Cruise that uses GPS technology to match topography on up to 4,500 hills.

Thanks again to Mack-to Steve and to Curtis-for an excellent presentation and evening!
