## New Policies

There are some additional Covid-19 related policies that are in place and must be complied with. These are to try and keep you and your family as safe as possible.

Unfortunately, It will not be possible to social distance within the studio space. This is why extra precautions have been put into place and we must make you aware of this before you arrive for your shoot. It is with regret that some of these changes do take away from the welcoming/friendly service we are proudly known for.



Please read the following rules we have had to put in place:

- Deep cleaning before and after every shoot.
- Hand sanitising station will be provided and need to be used upon entering and leaving the studio.
- Photographers will wear aprons and face coverings/shields for the duration of the shoot.
- Clients are asked to wear face coverings for the duration of the shoot however, these may be removed for a family photo. Masks must then be out back on after the photos have been taken.
- Access to the studio via the back gate to the garden. This will be open for you to come through and we will be there to welcome you. There will be a sign that will help show you where to go.

- There will unfortunately be no access to toilet facilities. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
- You are more than welcome to bring along your own drinks and snacks but we do ask that you take your own rubbish away with you. Unfortunately we have had to remove our welcome drink station for the time being.
- Shoes are asked to be removed as you are enter the shooting space and left on the doormat.
- Both parents are welcome to stay for the duration of the session however if there are siblings also attending, we kindly ask they are taken away/collected by someone else after their photos have been taken. Family and sibling images will be taken at the start if you are wishing to have them. (No additional adults are able to attend if both parents are in the studio.)
